



**AN ACT TO *REPEAL* AND *REENACT* §67106 OF CHAPTER 67, DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SOLICITATION, ACCEPTANCE, UTILIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF GIFTS, BEQUESTS AND DONATIONS, AND TO *ADD* NEW §§67109 AND 67105.1 OF CHAPTER 67, DIVISION 3 OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE VETERANS AFFAIRS FUND.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** §67106 of Chapter 67, Division 3 of Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *repealed* and *reenacted* to read as follows:

“§67106. **Solicitation, Acceptance, Utilization and Administration of Gifts, Bequests and Donations.** The Veterans Affairs Officer may solicit, accept, utilize and administer on behalf of the Office of Veterans Affairs, gifts, bequests and donations. The funds received shall be deposited into the Veterans Affairs Fund. Such gifts, bequests and donations shall be used for the maintenance of the Veterans Cemetery of Guam, the maintenance of the Veterans Affairs office, the sponsorship of events for veterans and purposes intended by the donor which are consistent with the goals and objectives of the Office of Veterans Affairs as stated in this Section. A quarterly report shall be submitted by the Veterans Affairs Officer to *I Maga’lahen Guåhan*, the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, and the Public Auditor, describing the solicitation, acceptance, utilization and administration of gifts, bequests and donations, and posted on the Office’s website.”

**Section 2.** A new §67109 is hereby *added* to Chapter 67, Division 3 of Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

“§67109. **Veterans Affairs Fund.** There is hereby created, separate and apart from other funds of the government of Guam, a special fund known as the Veterans Affairs Fund (the “Fund”). The Fund shall not be commingled with the General Fund or any other funds of the government of Guam. The Guam Veterans Commission shall approve all expenditures paid from the Fund. The Veterans Affairs Officer shall be the administrator of the Fund, and may issue warrants of expenditure pursuant to §67106 of this Chapter and shall maintain a record of all donations and expenditures.”

**Section 3. Repeal.** Section 77113(c) of Title 21, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *repealed*.

**Section 4. New Section 67105.1 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated.** A new Section 67105.1 is hereby *added* to Chapter 67, Division 3 of Title 10, Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

“§67105.1. **Veterans Cemetery Trust Fund.** The Veterans Cemetery Trust Fund is transferred from the Guam Parks Commission to the Guam Veterans Commission. Any money paid by the Federal government to Guam in connection with the use of the cemetery shall be deposited in the Veterans Cemetery Trust Fund and used for the maintenance of the cemetery. Expenditures from the Fund shall be by direction of the Guam Veterans Commission, which shall annually account to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* for the use of the Fund.”

**AN ACT TO REPEAL AND REENACT §67106 OF CHAPTER 67, DIVISION 3, OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SOLICITATION, ACCEPTANCE, UTILIZATION AND ADMINISTRATION OF GIFTS, BEQUESTS AND DONATIONS, AND TO ADD §67107 OF CHAPTER 67, DIVISION 3, OF TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE VETERANS AFFAIRS FUND.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** §67106 of Chapter 67, Division 3 of Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby repealed and reenacted to read as follows:

**“§67106. Solicitation, Acceptance, Utilization and Administration of Gifts, Bequests and Donations.** The Veterans Affairs Officer shall be authorized to solicit, accept, utilize and administer on behalf of the Office of Veterans Affairs, gifts, bequests and donations. Such funds as are received shall be deposited into the Veterans Affairs Fund. Utilization of such gifts, bequests and donations shall be for the maintenance of the Veteran’s Cemetery of Guam, the maintenance of the Veterans Affairs Office on Lot 8, Block 19, Tract 2025, the sponsorship of events for Veterans and purposes intended by the giver, or donor not inconsistent with the goals and objectives

1 of the Office of Veterans Affairs as stated in this Section. A quarterly report  
2 shall be submitted by the Veterans Affairs Officer to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* and  
3 the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, reporting on the solicitation, acceptance,  
4 utilization and administration of gifts, bequests and donations.

5 **Section 2.** A new §67107 is hereby added to Chapter 67, Division 3 of  
6 Title 10 of the Guam Code Annotated, is hereby repealed and reenacted to  
7 read as follows:

8 **“§67107. Veterans Affairs Fund.** There is hereby created, separate and  
9 apart from other funds of the government of Guam, a special fund known as  
10 the Veterans Affairs Fund (the “Fund”). The Fund shall not be commingled  
11 with the General Fund or any other funds of the government of Guam. The  
12 Veterans Affairs Officer shall be the administrator of the Fund, and is  
13 authorized to issue warrants of expenditure pursuant to §67106 of this  
14 Chapter.”
