AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM TO TRANSFER FUNDS BETWEEN APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

System. The Superintendent of Education is authorized to transfer funds between appropriations made in Section 1(a), Part I of Chapter II of Public Law 29-19 for the Fiscal Year 2008 funding requirements of the Guam Public School System, provided, that the Superintendent of Education *shall* submit a report of such transfer(s) to *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan no later than* fifteen (15) working days before transfers are made. Funds required to

1	pay all legal outstanding personnel obligations for current and past years shall not	
2	be transferred for other use pursuant to this Section.	
3	Section 2. Section 3 of Public Law 29-82 is hereby amended to read as	
4	follows:	
5	"Section 3. A new Section 13 is hereby added to Public Law 29-69	
6	to read as follows:	
7	'Section 13. Authority to Borrow. I Maga'lahen Guåhan, on	
8	behalf of the government of Guam, is authorized to borrow an amount	
9	not to exceed Thirteen Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars	
0	(\$13,800,000) and to execute a financial agreement with any bank or	
l 1	commercial lending institution licensed on Guam, government of	
12	Guam autonomous agency or any other instrumentality of the	
13	government of Guam. The terms of the loan shall include the	
14	following:	
15	(a) I Maga'lahen Guåhan shall use the Thirteen Million Eight	
16	Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$13,800,000) of such loan for the purpose	
17	of paying delinquent streetlight arrearage (streetlight delinquency)	
18	owed to the Guam Power Authority;	
9	(b) prepaid charges shall not be levied by the bank or entity for	
20	opening a line of credit;	
21	(c) interest derived from the financial agreement shall be	
22	exempt from taxation by the government of Guam;	
23	(d) repayment of the loan shall commence on July 1, 2008 and	
24	shall run for a period not less than four (4) years, all other terms of the	
25	financial agreement shall be negotiated by I Maga'lahen Guåhan in	
26	the best interest of the People of Guam.	

(e) the interest rate *shall* be negotiated between *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* and the lender, such interest rate *shall not exceed* seven percent (7%) per annum and *shall* be computed on a three hundred sixty-five (365) day calendar upon the actual amount extended to the government, and is to be paid monthly;

- (f) the loan may be secured by pledge of funds, including the revenues derived by the government of Guam under § 30 of the Organic Act of Guam. To ensure payment of the loan, there are hereby appropriated from the General Fund, or any other pledged revenues, such sums as will equal in each year the amount of money necessary for the repayment of the principal, interest and other costs associated with the financing; and
- (g) notwithstanding any substantive or procedural provision of Chapter 6 of Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated, the government of Guam hereby waives immunity from any suit or action in contract on the Loan, but does not waive sovereign immunity as to the personal liability of elected or appointed officials and employees of the government of Guam.'"
