





**AN ACT TO ADD NEW §§2228 AND 2229 TO CHAPTER

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new §2228 is *added* to Chapter 22 of Title 15, Guam Code
3 Annotated, to read:

4 **“§ 2228. Electronically Stored Documents of Deceased.**

5 (a) As used in this Section, *custodian* means any person who
6 electronically stores the documents or information of another person.

1 (b) A custodian *shall* provide to the personal representative of the
2 estate of a deceased person, who was domiciled in Guam at the time of the
3 person's death, access to or copies of any documents or information of the
4 deceased person stored electronically by the custodian upon receipt by the
5 custodian of:

6 (1) a written request for access or copies made by the
7 personal representative, accompanied by a copy of the death
8 certificate and a certified copy of the personal representative's letters
9 testamentary; or

10 (2) an order of a court having probate jurisdiction of the
11 deceased person's estate.

12 (c) A custodian *may not* destroy or dispose of the electronically
13 stored documents or information of the deceased person for two (2) years
14 after the custodian receives a request or order under Subsection (b).

15 (d) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to require a custodian
16 to disclose any information:

17 (1) in violation of any applicable federal law; or

18 (2) to which the deceased person would *not* have been
19 permitted access in the ordinary course of business by the custodian."

20 **Section 2.** A new §2229 is *added* to Chapter 22 of Title 15, Guam Code
21 Annotated, to read:

22 **"§ 2229. Digital Accounts, Inter-alia.**

23 The personal representative of an estate *shall* have the power, where
24 otherwise authorized, to take control of, conduct, continue, or terminate any
25 accounts of a deceased person on any social networking website, any
26 blogging or short message service website, or any e-mail service websites."

COMMITTEE REPORT DIGEST

I. OVERVIEW

Bill No. 72-32 (LS) was introduced on March 25, 2013 by Senator V. Anthony Ada, and was subsequently referred by the Committee on Rules to the Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Veterans' Affairs, Homeland Security and Judiciary on March 26, 2013.

The Committee on Guam US Military Relocation, Veterans' Affairs, Homeland Security and Judiciary convened a public hearing on Bill No. 72-32 (COR) on April 18, 2013 at 9:00 AM in I Liheslatura's Public Hearing Room.

Public Notice Requirements

Public Hearing notices were disseminated e-mail to all senators and all main media broadcasting outlets on April 11, 2013 (5-Day Notice), and again on April 16, 2013 (48-Hour Notice). Notices were also published in the Marianas Variety Newspaper on April 11, 2013 and April 17, 2013.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Aguon:

Opens the agenda on Bill 72-32 (COR), "An act to add a new §2228 to Chapter 22 of 15GCA relative to including digital assets in a decedent's estate" and recognizes sponsor's statement from Senator V. Anthony Ada given his absence.

Senator Ada's Testimony: The intent of the bill is to update our statutes to include the disposition of electronic documents of deceased persons. Electronic documents vary in nature. They could be emails, music and video files, ebooks or even a multi-million dollar online business. They are intellectual property of the deceased and should be treated as property for probate purposes.

Senator Aguon goes on to state that his initial discussion with Senator V. Anthony Ada in regards to Bill 72-32, Senator Ada informed him that there have been a few instances

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Section 2228 is *added* to Chapter 22 of 15GCA to read:

§2228. Electronically stored documents of deceased.

(a) As used in this section, "custodian" means any person who electronically stores the documents or information of another person.

(b) A custodian shall provide to the personal representative of the estate of a deceased person, who was domiciled in Guam at the time of the person's death, access to or copies of any documents or information of the deceased person stored electronically by the custodian upon receipt by the custodian of:

(1) a written request for access or copies made by the personal representative, accompanied by a copy of the death certificate and a certified copy of the personal representative's letters testamentary; or

(2) an order of a court having probate jurisdiction of the deceased person's estate.

1 (c) A custodian may not destroy or dispose of the electronically stored documents or
2 information of the deceased person for two (2) years after the custodian receives a
3 request or order under subsection (b).

4 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to require a custodian to disclose any
