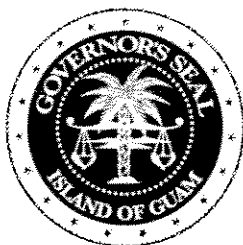





**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 5404 TO ARTICLE 8,

JOSE D. LEON GUERRERO PORT AUTHORITY OF
GUAM (PAG).**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Port Authority of Guam procures supplies and equipment using revenues
4 generated from rates and tariffs charged to its customers/ratepayers, and *not* from

1 the government of Guam General Fund. When these supplies and equipment
2 become excess or surplus, the disposal thereof is conducted in accordance with
3 Guam Procurement law and regulations. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that
4 an objective of the government of Guam supply management program is to obtain
5 a fair return of value upon disposal of surplus or excess supplies and equipment.

6 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that net proceeds from the disposal of
7 surplus supplies and equipment are credited to the General Fund, in accordance
8 with Guam Procurement law *unless* otherwise exempted. It is the intent of *I*
9 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* to credit the net proceeds from the disposal of PAG surplus
10 supplies and equipment back to PAG for the purpose of supplementing its
11 operations and maintenance budget.

12 **Section 2.** A new §5404 is hereby *added* to Article 8, Chapter 5 of Title 5,
13 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

14 **“§ 5404. Disposal of Excess Supplies and Surplus Equipment**
15 **by the Port Authority of Guam.** Notwithstanding the provisions of §5403
16 (Allocation of Proceeds from Sale or Disposal of Surplus Supplies), when
17 the Port Authority of Guam engages in disposing of excess or surplus
18 supplies and equipment that were purchased with funds generated from
19 rates, tariffs, or other sources of the Port Authority of Guam and *not* from
20 the General Fund, ninety percent (90%) of the total proceeds from the sale,
21 lease or disposal *shall* revert to the Port Authority of Guam and the
22 remaining ten percent (10%) of the total proceeds *shall* be deposited into the
23 Guam Procurement Advisory Council Support Fund, and *shall* be
24 administered in accordance with §5906 of this Chapter. The Port Authority
25 of Guam *shall not* transfer, sell, trade-in, or otherwise dispose of supplies
26 and equipment owned by the Port Authority of Guam without the
27 authorization of the Port Authority’s Board of Directors.”

1 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon
2 enactment.

3 **Section 4. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this law or its
4 application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law,
5 such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which
6 can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the
7 provisions of this law are severable.



12 **Section 2.** A new §5404 is hereby *added* to Article 8, Chapter 5 of Title 5,
13 Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

14 **“§ 5404. Disposal of Excess Supplies and Surplus Equipment**
15 **by the Port Authority of Guam.** Notwithstanding the provisions of §5403
16 (Allocation of Proceeds from Sale or Disposal of Surplus Supplies), when
17 the Port Authority of Guam engages in disposing of excess or surplus
18 supplies and equipment that were purchased with funds generated from
19 rates, tariffs, or other sources of the Port Authority of Guam and *not* from
20 the General Fund, ninety percent (90%) of the total proceeds from the sale,



Committee Report Digest

I. OVERVIEW

The Committee on General Government Operations and Cultural Affairs convened a public hearing on Thursday, August 29, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Hearing Room of *I Liheslatura*. Among the items on the agenda was the consideration was Bill No. 157-32 (COR) - T.C. Ada / R.J. Respicio / B.J.F. Cruz - An act to add a new §5404 to 5 GCA Chapter 5 relative to the proceeds derived from the disposal of excess or surplus supplies and equipment.

Public Notice Requirements

All legal requirements for public notices were met, with requests for publication sent to all media and all Senators on August 22, 2013, and August 27, 2013 via email. Copies of the hearing notices are appended to the report.

The public hearing was called to order at 10:05 a.m.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY AND DISCUSSION

Vice Speaker Benjamin J.F Cruz announced Bill No. 157-32 (COR) then read a sponsor statement on behalf of Senator Thomas Ada:

“Sponsor Statement - Bill 157

Thank you Vice Speaker Cruz for hearing Bill 157-32 today. While I am unable to attend, I have agreed to continue with the Bill’s hearing as I believe this legislation will significantly benefit our island and, as such, is worthy of speedy action. To that end, I submit the following Sponsor Statement and thank Senator Respicio for reading it onto the record.



Currently, surplus supplies and equipment, upon becoming obsolete or outliving their economic usefulness, are sold off by GSA and proceeds are directed to the General Fund.

While this process is appropriate for line agencies, Bill 157-32 recognizes that surplus originally bought by Autonomous Agencies, such as the Port, Guam Power Authority, and Guam Waterworks Authority, were purchased with funds generated from their respective customer bases. By redirecting funds from the sale of surplus supplies and equipment away from these agencies, ratepayers island-wide are negatively impacted.

Bill 157-32 proposes returning proceeds from a surplus sale back to the owning agency's coffers. The agency will then be able to use such proceeds to defray the costs of purchasing replacement equipment and undertake other needed capital improvements, thus keeping rates low for customers.

I should further note that all existing aspects of the procurement process, including the method by which GSA manages and executes the sale of surplus equipment, shall remain the same; only the directing of funds, in which the proceeds of surplus sales will be now be returned to the autonomous agency's fund from which the item was originally financed, will be amended.

I wish to thank Senator Respicio and Vice Speaker Cruz for joining me in co-sponsoring Bill 157-32 in an effort to keep rates low for our island community, and I look forward to its timely enactment into law."

Senator Cruz stated nobody signed up to testify or were present to provide oral testimony; therefore, he adjourned the public hearing for Bill No. 157-32 (COR).

4 nonexpendable supplies and equipment using revenues generated from rates and tariffs
5 charged to their customers/ratepayers. When these supplies and equipment have a
6 remaining useful life but are no longer required by the using agency or public corporation
7 in possession of the supplies they are deemed to be excess supplies, or if the supplies
8 become obsolete or have completed their useful life cycle, they are deemed to be surplus
9 supplies. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that an objective of the Government of
10 Guam supply management program is to obtain a fair return of value upon disposal of
11 surplus or excess supplies.

12 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that net proceeds from the disposition of
13 excess or surplus supplies and equipment are credited to the General Fund. It is the intent
14 of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to credit the net proceeds from the disposal of excess and
15 surplus supplies and equipment owned by autonomous agencies and public corporations
16 to the owning autonomous agencies and public corporations for the purpose of procuring
17 replacement supplies and equipment.

19 **Section 2.** A new §5404 is added to 5 GCA Chapter 5 to read as follows:

Sponsor Statement
Bill 157

Thank you Vice Speaker Cruz for hearing Bill 157-32 today. While I am unable to attend, I have agreed to continue with the Bill's hearing as I believe this legislation will significantly benefit our island and, as such, is worthy of speedy action. To that end, I submit the following Sponsor Statement and thank Senator Respicio for reading it onto the record.

Currently, surplus supplies and equipment, upon becoming obsolete or outliving their economic usefulness, are sold off by GSA and proceeds are directed to the General Fund.

While this process is appropriate for line agencies, Bill 157-32 recognizes that surplus originally bought by Autonomous Agencies, such as the Port, Guam Power Authority, and Guam Waterworks Authority, were purchased with funds generated from their respective customer bases. By redirecting funds from the sale of surplus supplies and equipment away from these agencies, ratepayers island-wide are negatively impacted.

Bill 157-32 proposes returning proceeds from a surplus sale back to the owning agency's coffers. The agency will then be able to use such proceeds to defray the costs of purchasing replacement equipment and undertake other needed capital improvements, thus keeping rates low for customers.

I should further note that all existing aspects of the procurement process, including the method by which GSA manages and executes the sale of surplus equipment, shall remain the same; only the directing of funds, in which the proceeds of surplus sales will now be returned to the autonomous agency's fund from which the item was originally financed, will be amended.

I wish to thank Senator Respicio and Vice Speaker Cruz for joining me in co-sponsoring Bill 157-32 in an effort to keep rates low for our island community, and I look forward to its timely enactment into law.

**AN ACT TO ADD A NEW §5404 TO 5 GCA CHAPTER 5
RELATIVE TO THE PROCEEDS DERIVED FROM THE
DISPOSAL OF EXCESS OR SURPLUS SUPPLIES AND
EQUIPMENT.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that
3 autonomous Government of Guam agencies and public corporations procure
4 nonexpendable supplies and equipment using revenues generated from rates and tariffs
5 charged to their customers/ratepayers. When these supplies and equipment have a
6 remaining useful life but are no longer required by the using agency or public corporation
7 in possession of the supplies they are deemed to be excess supplies, or if the supplies
8 become obsolete or have completed their useful life cycle, they are deemed to be surplus
9 supplies. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that an objective of the Government of
10 Guam supply management program is to obtain a fair return of value upon disposal of
11 surplus or excess supplies.

12 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that net proceeds from the disposition of
13 excess or surplus supplies and equipment are credited to the General Fund. It is the intent
14 of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to credit the net proceeds from the disposal of excess and
15 surplus supplies and equipment owned by autonomous agencies and public corporations
16 to the owning autonomous agencies and public corporations for the purpose of procuring
17 replacement supplies and equipment.

19 **Section 2.** A new §5404 is added to 5 GCA Chapter 5 to read as follows:

1 “§ 5404. Disposal of Excess Supplies and Equipment by an Autonomous Agency
2 or Public Corporation.

3 (a) Notwithstanding the provisions of §5403 (Allocation of Proceeds from Sale or
4 Disposal of Surplus Supplies), when excess or surplus supplies and equipment, purchased
5 with funds generated from rates, tariffs, or sources that are derived from the customers of
6 the autonomous agency or public corporation, and not from the General Fund, are
7 disposed of, the proceeds from the sale, lease or disposal shall be allocated back to the
8 owning autonomous agency or public corporation.

9 (b) Said proceeds shall be used solely for the purchase of replacement equipment
10 or other capital improvement requirements needed to support the operations of the
11 autonomous agency or public corporation.

12 (c) Autonomous Agencies and Public Corporations affected by this chapter
13 include: the A.B. Won Pat Guam International Airport Authority, the Guam Housing
14 Corporation, the Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority, the Guam Regional
15 Transit Authority, the Guam Power Authority, the Guam Visitor’s Bureau, the Port
16 Authority of Guam, the Public Defender Corporation, the Public Utilities Commission,
17 the Guam Waterworks Authority, and the Guam Economic Development Authority.”

19 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
20

21 **Section 4. Severability.** *If* any of the provisions of this law or its application to
22 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
23 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this law which can be given effect without
24 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this law are
25 severable.
