BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new Article 5 is *added* to Chapter 3 of Title 22, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

“ARTICLE 5

RIGHT TO PRIVACY IN THE WORKPLACE ACT

§ 3501. Prohibited Inquiries.

1 (a) It *shall* be unlawful for any employer to ask any employee to
2 provide any username, password, or other related account information in
3 order to gain access to a social networking website where that employee
4 maintains an account or profile.

5 (b) It *shall* be unlawful for any employer to ask any prospective
6 employee to provide any username, password, or other related account
7 information in order to gain access to a social networking website where that
8 prospective employee maintains an account or profile.

9 (c) It *shall* be unlawful for any employer to ask any employee to
10 provide any username, password, or other related account information in
11 order to gain access to a non-employer provided email account.

12 (d) It *shall* be unlawful for any employer to ask any prospective
13 employee to provide any username, password, or other related account
14 information in order to gain access to a non-employer provided email
15 account.

16 (e) The prohibitions in Subsections (a), (b), (c) or (d), *supra*, *shall*



I. OVERVIEW

BILL NO. 183-32 (COR) - "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW ARTICLE 5 TO CHAPTER 3 OF 22GCA RELATIVE TO PRIVACY OF EMPLOYEES' PERSONAL INFORMATION," was introduced by **Senator V. Anthony Ada** and **Senator Rory J. Respicio** on September 11, 2013; and was subsequently referred to the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform on September 12, 2013.

Senator Rory J. Respicio, Chairperson of the Committee on Rules; Federal, Foreign & Micronesian Affairs; and Human & Natural Resources; and Election Reform convened a public hearing on **Bill No. 183-32 (COR)** on Thursday, January 23, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. in the Legislature's Public Hearing Room to receive public testimony on the measure.

II. SUMMARY OF TESTIMONY & DISCUSSION

Senator Rory J. Respicio called the public hearing to order at 10:00 A.M. and deferred to Senator V. Anthony Ada as main sponsor of **Bill No. 183-32 (COR)**, to provide opening remarks.

Senator V. Anthony Ada: Thank you Mr. Chair and thank you also for being a co-sponsor on Bill No. 183-32 (COR). This bill makes it unlawful for employers to ask any personal information from any employee or potential employee for their password or user name for any social networking site or any private email. What this does in short is that we just want to ensure that the rights of employees or potential employees are protected especially of the privacy of their personal information.

Senator Respicio: Thank you Senator Ada. No individuals have signed up to testify and I will consider this bill publically heard having met all the requirements of the Open Government Law and only to state that I am happy to co-sponsor this bill because it will help protect many people, even in our government.

Senator Respicio thanked the senators present at the hearing.

No further testimony being offered, Senator Respicio then declared that **Bill No. 183-32 (COR)** was duly heard.

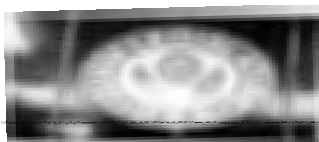

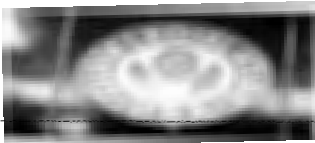

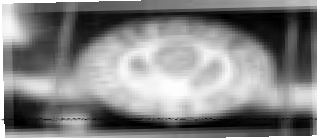

Thus, the annual revenue impact will be determined by the number of violators found guilty and fine assessed per year. Because of the lack of historical data, the potential revenue impact is undetermined at this time.
