

**AN ACT TO CONSOLIDATE AND REZONE LOT NOS.
5010-1NEW, 5042-1, AND 5042-R1 IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF *DEDEDO* FROM MULTIPLE
DWELLING ZONE (R2) TO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL ZONE
(M1) TO ALLOW FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND
OPERATION OF A POWER GENERATION PLANT ON
BEHALF OF THE GUAM POWER AUTHORITY OR ITS
SUCCESSOR.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds
that the Guam Power Authority (GPA) needs to have constructed a new power plant
to replace aging and damaged power plants, and GPA has determined that the new
power plant should be built in northern Guam.

1 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that GPA has located a suitable site for a
2 new power generation plant (plant) in the *Ukudu* area in the municipality of *Dededo*.
3 The new plant will be best sited within a specific section of the *Ukudu* area due to
4 the proximity of the GPA Harmon Substation and the Northern District Wastewater
5 Treatment Plant, terrain characteristics, environmental considerations, and other
6 unique factors. The plant's proximity to the Northern District Wastewater Treatment
7 Plant will eliminate the need of up to three million (3,000,000) gallons of water daily
8 by utilizing treated wastewater from the nearby GWA Wastewater Treatment Plant.
9 The proposed site will reduce the significant costs related to transmission lines,
10 construction, operations, and maintenance, and it will provide maximum reliability
11 by also being in the proximity of the GPA *Harmon* Substation.

12 Although the purchase of real property is not subject to the Guam Procurement
13 Law, GPA initially attempted to procure real property via the process prescribed in
14 5 GCA § 5211.

15 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in June 2017, GPA issued a
16 Statement of Interest to acquire real property with certain criteria within a prescribed
17 area of *Ukudu*. The Statement of Interest was advertised in both Guam newspapers,
18 posted on the GPA webpage, and announced to the Guam Association of Realtors.
19 As a result, five (5) responses were received, and two (2) were subsequently
20 disqualified. The three (3) remaining responses were evaluated based on the criteria
21 contained in the original Statement of Interest. GPA reviewed the responses,
22 discussed the acquisition process, and allowed open dialogue with the remaining
23 owners or representatives of owners. Discussions included title and appraisal
24 information on Lot Nos. 5010-1NEW, 5042-1, and 5042-R1 in the municipality of
25 *Dededo*, and a Purchase Contract was subsequently negotiated.

26 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that on October 13, 2017, the
27 Consolidated Commission on Utilities (CCU) adopted Resolution No. 2017-42,
28 Relative to Authorizing GPA to Acquire Real Property for a 180MW Power

1 Generation Plant. The CCU had authorized the General Manager of GPA to execute
2 the real property purchase agreement up to Ten Million Eight Hundred Seventy
3 Thousand Dollars (\$10,870,000), to commence rezoning efforts, and to petition the
4 Public Utilities Commission (PUC) for approval to purchase the real property.

5 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that all of the GPA power plants, except
6 for one (1) of the nine (9) power plants that GPA currently operates, were
7 constructed on military property where there are no zoning requirements, or were
8 allowed to be built as a conditional use of the property regardless of the zoning
9 designation. One (1) location was rezoned to Industrial Zone (M2).

10 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to consolidate and rezone the
11 properties described as Lot No. 5010-1NEW, Lot No. 5042-1, and Lot No. 5042-R1
12 in the municipality of *Dededo* from Multiple Dwelling Zone (R2) to Light Industrial
13 Zone (M1) to allow for the construction and operation of GPA's new power
14 generation plant thereon solely on behalf of the Guam Power Authority or its
15 successor.

16 **Section 2. Consolidation and Rezoning of Lot No. 5010-1NEW, Lot No.**
17 **5042-1, and Lot No. 5042-R1 in the Municipality of *Dededo*.**

18 Lot No. 5010-1NEW, Lot No. 5042-1, and Lot No. 5042-R1 in the
19 municipality of *Dededo* are hereby consolidated and rezoned from Multiple
20 Dwelling Zone (R2) to Light Industrial Zone (M1) to allow for the construction and
21 operation of a power generation plant solely on behalf of the Guam Power Authority
22 or its successor.

23 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
24 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, that invalidity
25 *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
26 without the invalid provisions or applications, and to this end the provisions of this
27 Act are severable.
