AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF SEVEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$7,900,000) FROM THE 2018 GENERAL FUND TAX AMNESTY PROGRAM AS FOLLOWS: SIX MILLION EIGHT HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$6,800,000) TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR ITS OPERATIONS IN FISCAL YEAR 2018, INCLUSIVE OF CORRECTING THE DEFICIENCIES AS IDENTIFIED IN THE CENTERS FOR MEDICARE AND MEDICAID SERVICES SURVEY REPORT; FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) TO THE UNIFIED JUDICIARY TO IMPLEMENT AN ELECTRONIC MONITORING PROGRAM FOR GUAM'S PRETRIAL AND CRIMINAL OFFENDER POPULATIONS IN FISCAL YEAR 2019; FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$500,000) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS; AND ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000) TO THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PAY ALLOWANCES TO MEMBERS OF THE CIVILIAN VOLUNTEER POLICE RESERVE.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that
3 the Guam Tax Amnesty Program for Fiscal Year 2018 is expected to generate in excess
4 of Thirty Million Dollars (\$30,000,000) in additional General Fund revenues.

5 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to authorize and appropriate such sums
6 as are identified in this Act: to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority to subsidize its
7 operations for Fiscal Year 2018, inclusive of correcting the deficiencies as identified in
8 the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services survey report; to the Unified Judiciary
9 to implement an electronic monitoring program for Guam's pretrial and criminal
10 offender populations in Fiscal Year 2019; to the Department of Corrections; and to
11 Guam Police Department to pay allowances to members of the Civilian Volunteer
12 Police Reserve.

13 **Section 2. Appropriations to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority, the**
14 **Unified Judiciary, the Department of Corrections, and the Guam Police**
15 **Department.** The sum of up to Seven Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars
16 (\$7,900,000) from the 2018 General Fund Tax Amnesty Program is appropriated as
17 follows: (a) Six Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,800,000) is appropriated
18 to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority for its operations in Fiscal Year 2018,
19 inclusive of correcting the deficiencies as identified in the Centers for Medicare and
20 Medicaid Services survey report; (b) notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
21 sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) of the General Fund Tax Amnesty
22 Program proceeds received in Fiscal Year 2018 *shall* be used by the Unified Judiciary
23 to implement an electronic monitoring program for Guam's pretrial and criminal
24 offender populations in Fiscal Year 2019; (c) notwithstanding any other provision of
25 law, rule or regulation, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) of the
26 General Fund Tax Amnesty Program proceeds received in Fiscal Year 2018 *shall* be
27 used by the Department of Corrections in Fiscal Year 2019; and (d) notwithstanding
28 any other provision of law, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) of

1 the General Fund Tax Amnesty Program proceeds received in Fiscal Year 2018 *shall*
2 be used by the Guam Police Department for the *sole* purpose of paying allowances to
3 members of the Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve as authorized by 10 GCA, Chapter
4 66, § 66104.1.

5 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon enactment.

6 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
7 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or
8 applications of this Act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or
9 application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
