

- 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:
- 2 Section 1. Use of Pell Grant and Student Financial Assistance Fund. §
- 3 28202(a) of Article 2, Chapter 28, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is amended to
- 4 read:

"(a) Tuition and Fees at the University of Guam. Tuition and fees for each academic year to be paid by the Student Financial Assistance Fund for a period of not more than four (4) years in an undergraduate program at the University of Guam, except that merit award recipients who are eligible and receive the Federal Pell Grant under 20 U.S.C. § 1070a of the Higher Education Act of 1965, as amended, shall have their Pell Grant applied to their tuition and fees charges for each academic year prior to the expenditure of funds from the Student Financial Assistance Fund. Expenditure from the Student Financial Assistance Fund shall be equal to the remaining balance of a recipient's tuition and fees after subtracting the recipient's Federal Pell Grant award for the academic year."

Section 2. Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies. § 28202(c) of Article 2, Chapter 28, of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is amended to read:

"(c) Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies. Each student receiving an award under this Article *shall* be entitled to an additional Three Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) per semester for textbooks and school supplies."
