**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 28202(a) AND (c) OF ARTICLE 2,  
CHAPTER 28, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,  
RELATIVE TO THE TUITION AND FEES BENEFIT FOR  
MERIT AWARD RECIPIENTS UNDER THE STUDENT  
FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS FOR HIGHER  
EDUCATION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Use of Pell Grant and Student Financial Assistance Fund. §**  
3 **28202(a) of Article 2, Chapter 28, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to**  
4 **read:**

1           “(a) Tuition and Fees at the University of Guam. Tuition and fees for  
2 each academic year to be paid by the Student Financial Assistance Fund for a  
3 period of not more than four (4) years in an undergraduate program at the  
4 University of Guam, *except* that merit award recipients who are eligible and  
5 receive the Federal Pell Grant under 20 U.S.C. § 1070a of the Higher  
6 Education Act of 1965, as amended, *shall* have their Pell Grant applied to their  
7 tuition and fees charges for each academic year prior to the expenditure of  
8 funds from the Student Financial Assistance Fund. Expenditure from the  
9 Student Financial Assistance Fund *shall* be equal to the remaining balance of  
10 a recipient’s tuition and fees after subtracting the recipient’s Federal Pell  
11 Grant award for the academic year.”

12           **Section 2. Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies.** § 28202(c) of  
13 Article 2, Chapter 28, of Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

14           “(c) Allowance for Textbooks and School Supplies. Each student  
15 receiving an award under this Article *shall* be entitled to an additional Three  
16 Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$350.00) per semester for textbooks and school  
17 supplies.”
