AN ACT TO EXEMPT LOT B-1, TRACT 111, TUMON, MUNICIPALITY OF TAMUNING, FROM THE ALIENATION AND REVERTER CLAUSE AS STIPULATED IN SECTION 9(d) OF PUBLIC LAW 21-14.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that Public Law 21-14, which was enacted into law on April 20, 1991, authorized certain land sales and exchanges. The land sales involved substandard remnant pieces created when Ipao Road was realigned. These remnant pieces are valuable and usable only to the contiguous landowners. When purchased by the private contiguous landowner, the substandard remnant piece would then be consolidated

into a larger lot. The sales proceeds and real estate tax revenues generated by the taxation of the larger consolidated lot provides revenue for public services.

I Liheslatura finds that on May 17, 2012, the owner of the lot contiguous to Lot B-1, Tract 111, Tumon, municipality of Tamuning paid to the government the fair market value for the purchase of Lot B-1, Tract 111, Tumon, municipality of Tamuning, with the expectation that the government will execute the Ouitclaim Deed in a timely manner; however, said Quitclaim Deed was not executed until February 17, 2016. The optimal utilization of Lot B-1, Tract 111, Tumon, municipality of Tamuning, cannot be immediately realized unless the alienation and reverter clause restriction in Section 9(d) of Public Law 21-14 is removed.

ILiheslatura finds that the execution of the Quitclaim Deed for Lot B-1, Tract 111, Tumon, municipality of Tamuning, was not accomplished by the government of Guam until February 17, 2016; however, the provisions of Section 9(d) of Public Law 21-14 stipulate that the restrictions imposed by the alienation and revertion clause will not be lifted until ten (10) years from the date of execution of the Quitclaim Deed.

Since this is a fee simple transaction and no other qualified purchaser is identified in Public Law 21-14 for this parcel, *I Liheslatura* therefore intends to exempt Lot B-1, Tract 111, *Tumon*, municipality of *Tamuning*, from the ten (10) year alienation and reversion clause stipulated in Section 9(d) of Public Law 21-14.

Section 2. Exemption from Alienation and Reverter Clause.

Lot B-1, Tract 111, *Tumon*, municipality of *Tamuning*, *shall* be exempt from the alienation and reverter clause as stipulated in Section 9(d) of Public Law 21-14.

Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid, or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect

- 1 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this

- 3 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon its
