

**AN ACT TO AMEND § 3113 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3,
TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
MANDATING THE QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS
OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
CORRECTIONS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds that
3 in order to serve the people of Guam, persons in appointed positions must be able to
4 bring experience directly applicable to the agency they are appointed. This experience
5 becomes paramount in the realm of public safety. Public safety agencies on Guam with
6 positions appointed by *I Maga'lâhen Guáhan* are appointed with a certain level of
7 experience to ensure the safety of our people, and that those who work in the agency

1 are being led by someone familiar with how an agency like that operates. This model
2 may prove beneficial for the Department of Corrections.

3 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to ensure that for the safety
4 of the people of Guam and the protection of civil rights, the Department of Corrections
5 is led by someone who holds the experience necessary to understand the mechanisms
6 of the agency for the future of Guam's people.

7 **Section 2.** § 3113 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is
8 *amended* to read:

9 **“§ 3113. Department of Corrections.**

10 There is within the Executive Branch of the government of Guam a
11 Department of Corrections. The Director of Corrections is the head of the
12 Department of Corrections. The Director of Corrections is appointed by *I*
13 *Maga'låhi* (the Governor) with the advice and consent of *I Liheslatura* (the
14 Legislature), and *shall* meet the following qualifications:

15 (a) have no less than ten (10) years of progressive experience in
16 a law enforcement agency, including at least three (3) years in a senior law
17 enforcement position, or equivalent executive management experience in
18 the field of public administration, business administration, criminal justice
19 or law, or a closely related field or discipline;

20 (b) graduated with a Bachelor's degree or higher in criminal
21 justice, public administration, business administration, law, or a closely
22 related field or discipline from an accredited institution recognized by the
23 Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) or its successors;

24 (c) have no felony, domestic or family violence convictions;

25 (d) have no misdemeanor convictions involving moral turpitude;

1 (e) submit to and pass a drug screening test, including, but not
2 limited to, urinalysis testing, unless the appointee is a current employee of
3 the government of Guam registered with the Peace Officer Standards and
4 Training (POST) Commission as a peace officer occupying a Test-
5 Designated Position (TDP) pursuant to the Department's Drug-Free
6 Workplace Program;

7 (f) be of good health and good moral character;

8 (g) submit to psychological testing;

9 (h) submit to a polygraph examination; and

10 (i) submit to a thorough investigation of his or her background
11 and moral character.

12 Compensation of Director of the Department of Corrections.

13 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person appointed by *I*
14 *Maga'låhen Guåhan* and confirmed by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to be Director of
15 Corrections, and who at the time of his or her appointment is an active member
16 of the classified service, *shall* receive a salary established by the government of
17 Guam compensation schedule for heads of agencies, or a salary equivalent to the
18 three (3)-year average of the annual income earned immediately prior to his or
19 her appointment as Director of the Department of Corrections, whichever is
20 greater. Said three (3)-year average *shall* be reviewed annually to determine if
21 mandated pay increases would have affected the three (3)-year average.

22 A person who is an active classified employee of the government of Guam
23 immediately prior to his or her appointment by *I Maga'låhen Guåhan* and
24 confirmation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to be Director of the Department of
25 Corrections *shall*, if not removed for cause, be reinstated to the position he or she

1 previously held immediately prior to such appointment, or to an equivalent
2 position, upon expiration of his or her appointment as Director of Corrections.”

3 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective on January 1, 2019.

4 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
5 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
6 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
7 the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
8 severable.
