



**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (c) TO § 61543 OF  
SUBARTICLE 5, ARTICLE 5, CHAPTER 61, TITLE 21, GUAM  
CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ELECTRONIC  
SIGNAGE.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds  
3 that existing and authorized electronic signage businesses have incurred legitimate  
4 costs that may cause the government of Guam to be liable; and, that such businesses  
5 have been operating and pursuing operations in good faith.

1            *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that as the government of Guam seeks to  
2 modernize its electronic signage laws, it is necessary to ensure that those currently  
3 operating and authorized to operate are not unduly harmed by the government.

4            *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that antiquated laws should not impede  
5 legitimate businesses that are socially responsible.

6            It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to add a new Subsection  
7 (c) to § 61543 of Subarticle 5, Article 5, Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated,  
8 which allows those businesses that have been granted variances or have been issued  
9 a Notice of Action by the Guam Land Use Commission for such electronic signage  
10 to be legally authorized to operate; provided, that all business license requirements  
11 are met and are thereafter maintained in good standing.

12            **Section 2. Electronic Signage.** A new Subsection (c) is hereby *added* to §  
13 61543 of Subarticle 5, Article 5, Chapter 61, Title 21, Guam Code Annotated, to  
14 read:

15            “(c) Electronic signage that have been granted variances by the Guam  
16 Land Use Commission or have been issued a Notice of Action by the Guam  
17 Land Use Commission on or before May 15, 2017, *shall* be legally authorized  
18 to operate; provided, that all business license requirements are met and are  
19 thereafter maintained in good standing.”
