**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 4124 TO CHAPTER 4 OF
TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
ESTABLISHING MONTHLY CONSOLIDATED TAX
COLLECTIONS REPORTS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Short Title.** This Act *shall* be cited as the “Monthly
3 Consolidated Tax Collections Reporting Act.”

4 **Section 2. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds
5 that the Department of Revenue and Taxation is responsible for collecting most taxes
6 on Guam.

1 *I Liheslatura* finds that the Office of the Inspector General estimated that
2 inefficiencies at the Department of Revenue and Taxation result in a loss of at least
3 Twenty-three Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$23,500,000) each year.

4 *I Liheslatura* further finds that since the largest sources of revenue to the
5 government of Guam are the business privilege tax and the Guam territorial income
6 tax, comprised of the individual income tax, the withholding tax, and the corporate
7 income tax, closely monitoring the collections activities of these revenue sources
8 would both encourage improving the effectiveness of collections activities by the
9 Department of Revenue and Taxation, and also provide additional information
10 which may be useful in developing forecasts of revenue based, in part, upon
11 collection inventories and the degree to which such inventories may be expected to
12 result in payments which will be recognized as General Fund revenue.

13 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to require the Director of
14 the Department of Revenue and Taxation to prepare a monthly Consolidated Tax
15 Collections Report (CTCR) which *shall* report the monthly activity of the Collection
16 Branch of the Department of Revenue and Taxation for the individual income tax,
17 the withholding tax, the corporate income tax, and the business privilege tax, by
18 adding a new § 4124 to Chapter 4 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated.

19 **Section 3. Monthly Consolidated Tax Collections Report.** A new § 4124
20 is hereby *added* to Chapter 4 of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

21 “§ 4124. **Monthly Consolidated Tax Collections Report.** The
22 Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation *shall* prepare a monthly
23 Consolidated Tax Collections Report (CTCR), excluding any identifying
24 information regarding any taxpayer, which *shall* report the aggregate monthly
25 activity of the Collection Branch of the Department of Revenue and Taxation
26 for the individual income tax, the withholding tax, the corporate income tax,
27 and the business privilege tax, which *shall* include, broken down by tax units

1 and balance, the beginning inventory, referrals received during the month,
2 assessed accruals, total inventory, offsets, payments made to the Treasurer of
3 Guam, payment transfers, inactivation, abatements, total adjustments, and the
4 ending inventory. The Director of the Department of Revenue and Taxation
5 *shall* certify said reports, which *shall* be transmitted to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*
6 and the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* no later than twenty (20) days after
7 the end of each month.”




