





**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 51102(a)(3) OF CHAPTER 51,
TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
INCLUDING THE DEPARTMENT HEADS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND THE
AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIREFIGHTING UNIT AS
MEMBERS OF THE PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS
AND TRAINING (POST) COMMISSION.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Department of Youth Affairs employs forty-seven (47) recognized law
4 enforcement officers, and the Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting Unit, under the A.B.

1 Won Pat International Airport Authority, Guam, employs thirty-six (36) law
2 enforcement officers.

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the department heads of these
4 officers lack voting representation in the Peace Officer Standards and Training
5 (POST) Commission, which decides on rules and requirements for all law
6 enforcement officers on the island of Guam.

7 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to include the department
8 heads of the Department of Youth Affairs and the Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting
9 Unit as voting members of the POST Commission so that they may convey the
10 interests of their agencies and personnel during POST Commission meetings.

11 **Section 2.** § 51102(a)(3) of Chapter 51, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is
12 *amended* to read:

13 “(3) The Commission *shall* be composed of fifteen (15)
14 members as follows:

15 (A) the Chief of the Guam Police Department, or his
16 designated representative;

17 (B) the Chief of the Guam Airport Police, or his
18 designated representative;

19 (C) the Chief of the Guam Port Police, or his designated
20 representative;

21 (D) the Attorney General, or his designated
22 representative;

23 (E) the Director of the Customs and Quarantine
24 Agency, or his designated representative;

25 (F) the Director of the Department of Corrections, or
26 his designated representative;

1 (G) the Chief of the Division of Aquatic and Wildlife
2 Resources of the Department of Agriculture, or his designated
3 representative;

4 (H) one (1) non-voting representative from the
5 University of Guam (UOG), appointed by the President;

6 (I) one (1) non-voting representative from the Guam
7 Community College (GCC), appointed by the President;

8 (J) the Chief Marshal of the Unified Guam Judiciary,
9 or his designated representative;

10 (K) the Chief of the Guam Fire Department, or his
11 designated representative;

12 (L) the Chief of Probation of the Unified Judiciary, or
13 his designated representative;

14 (M) one (1) voting representative from the Department
15 of Administration, the Personnel Services Division
16 Administrator, appointed by the Director of Administration;

17 (N) the Director of the Department of Youth Affairs, or
18 his designated representative; and

19 (O) the Chief of the Aircraft Rescue and Firefighting
20 Unit, or his designated representative.”
