

AN ACT TO AMEND § 18120.1(b) OF CHAPTER 18, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CLARIFYING GUEST EDUCATOR QUALIFICATIONS PURSUANT TO THE BARBERING AND COSMETOLOGY ACT OF 2000.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
that the provision allowing Guest Educators to participate and contribute to the
success of Guam's cosmetology and barbering profession required possession of
both a license and either three (3) years of experience or a Master's degree. It was
not the intent of I Liheslatura to require such. By amending this section,

1	cosmetology and barbering schools will be able to enhance their educational
2	curricula by providing their students with professionals who serve not only in
3	cosmetology and barbering, but also in health and science, among other areas.
4	Section 2. § 18120.1(b) of Chapter 18, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, is
5	hereby amended to read:
6	"(b) Guest Educators shall meet the following qualifications:
7	(1) specialized competency in the fields of cosmetology, nail
8	technology, esthetics, or barbering, with at least one (1) year of
9	experience with license specialty; or
10	(2) certification in the field of instruction with at least three
11	(3) years of experience in the field of instruction in a post-secondary
12	school, or a Master's degree."
13	Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
14	person or circumstance is found to be invalid, or contrary to law, such invalidity
15	shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect
16	without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this
17	Act are severable.
18	Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
