


CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO *I MAGA'LÁHEN GUÁHAN*





AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CHÁMORRO LAND TRUST COMMISSION (CLTC) TO LEASE LOT 7161-R1, YIGO, GUAM, FOR A PERIOD OF UP TO FIFTY (50) YEARS, AND TO GIVE THE RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL TO THE GUAM RACING FEDERATION (GRF), FOR THE CONTINUED OPERATION OF THE GUAM INTERNATIONAL RACEWAY PARK, AND TO REQUIRE THE LEASE OF SAID LOT TO BE APPROVED BY THE LEGISLATURE.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds
3 that the Guam Racing Federation (GRF), a non-profit organization sanctioned by the

1 Department of Revenue and Taxation, was granted a license agreement by the
2 Chamorro Land Trust Commission (CLTC) to use Lot 7161-R1 in *Yigo*, Guam,
3 under Department of Land Management Instrument Number 503740. The license
4 term expired on May 31, 2018, with no remaining options to extend.

5 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also finds that during the twenty (20)-year license
6 period the GRF significantly contributed to the promotion and growth of sports
7 tourism by constructing the necessary racing facilities to enable the hosting of the
8 “Smokin’ Wheels” off-road races, an annual event that started in 1979, as well as
9 numerous other annual motor and non-motor racing events.

10 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also finds that during the twenty (20)-year license
11 period the development plans by the GRF for the Guam International Raceway Park
12 were placed on hold for approximately seven (7) years due to the uncertainty of the
13 military buildup and the location of the firing ranges.

14 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the raceway facility has effectively
15 provided a safe venue for speed testing and drag racing, virtually eliminating illegal
16 drag racing on Guam’s highways.

17 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to authorize the lease of Lot 7161-
18 R1 in *Yigo*, Guam for a period of up to fifty (50) years, and to allow the granting of
19 a “right of first refusal” to the GRF (the current licensee); and, to require that the
20 CLTC transmit to *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) a negotiated lease within one
21 hundred eighty (180) days from enactment of this Act.

22 **Section 2. Authorization to Lease.** Notwithstanding any other provisions
23 of law, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* authorizes the CLTC to lease Lot 7161-R1 in the
24 municipality of *Yigo* for a period of up to fifty (50) years for commercial purposes,
25 to include the operation of a raceway, related support facilities, and various outdoor
26 events.

1 **Section 3. Right of First Refusal.** The CLTC *shall* give right of first refusal
2 to the current licensee, the GRF; provided, that if granted right of first refusal, GRF
3 must express its intention in writing to the Executive Director of the CLTC no later
4 than fifteen (15) days from the date of enactment of this Act.

5 **Section 4. Lease Terms.** Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, *I*
6 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* authorizes the CLTC to negotiate the terms of the lease for Lot
7 7161-R1, municipality of *Yigo*, Guam; provided, that such negotiated lease *shall* be
8 submitted to *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature) for approval by statute.

9 If the current licensee, GRF, exercises the “right of first refusal,” the CLTC
10 *shall* within one hundred eighty (180) days from GRF’s exercise of the “right of first
11 refusal,” submit the lease negotiated with the GRF to *I Liheslatura* (the Legislature)
12 for approval by statute. Except as specifically provided in this Act, conditions of the
13 lease *shall* comply with 21 GCA § 75122. Notwithstanding any other provision of
14 law, mineral extraction is prohibited and *shall not* be included in the terms of the
15 lease.

16 **Section 5. Lease Revenues.**

17 (a) Proceeds from the leasing of Lot 7161-R1, municipality of *Yigo*,
18 *shall* be deposited into the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure
19 Fund Account during the term of the lease.

20 (b) All monies in the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and
21 Infrastructure Fund Account are hereby appropriated to the CLTC to be
22 expended in accordance with 21 GCA Chapter 75, and are not subject to *I*
23 *Maga'låhen Guåhan*’s transfer authority. The Administrative Director *shall*
24 comply with all existing reporting requirements by submitting a quarterly
25 report of the Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund Account
26 to *I Maga'låhen Guåhan*, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, and the Office of Public
27 Accountability. The Administrative Director *shall* ensure that the Chamorro

1 Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund Account is in compliance with all
2 existing statutes, rules and regulations, codes, executive orders, and any other
3 authority that is applicable to the Commission and the use of the funds in the
4 Chamorro Land Trust Survey and Infrastructure Fund Account pursuant to 21
5 GCA Chapter 75.

6 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
8 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
10 severable.
