

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that the Supreme Court of Guam in People v. Shimizu, 2017 Guam 11, deemed 9
- 4 GCA § 30.10(a)(2) as unconstitutionally vague. The court determined that the
- 5 language in the statute defining "family violence" as including "placing a family or

household member in fear of bodily injury" did not provide fair notice to ordinary citizens as to what conduct it prohibits, and it did not establish minimal guidelines to govern law enforcement.

Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to ensure that Guam's family violence laws are enforceable and that family violence cases are successfully prosecuted by amending 9 GCA § 30.10(a)(2) to ensure that the statute provides fair notice as to what conduct it prohibits, and to ensure that the statute establishes required guidelines for law enforcement.

Section 2. § 30.10(a)(2) of Chapter 30, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

"(2) placing another family or household member in reasonable fear of imminent bodily injury; or"
