



**AN ACT TO *REPEAL* AND *REENACT* § 3108 OF
ARTICLE 1, AND *AMEND* § 3202(a) OF ARTICLE 2,
BOTH OF CHAPTER 3, TITLE 19, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO NAMES ON MARRIAGE
LICENSES.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* finds
3 that there is a need to update Guam statutes regarding the choice of a name upon
4 marriage. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guáhan* to allow a spouse greater options
5 relative to his or her choice of a middle name and a surname, or a surname alone,
6 upon marriage by indicating such election on a marriage license application.

1 **Section 2.** § 3108 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 19, Guam Code Annotated,
2 is hereby *repealed* and *reenacted* to read:

3 **“§ 3108. Choices of Name Upon Marriage.**

4 (a) Upon entering into a contract of marriage, a spouse may
5 elect to retain his or her surname before marriage as his or her surname
6 after marriage, or a spouse may elect to adopt any of the following
7 surnames:

- 8 (1) the current surname of the other spouse;
- 9 (2) the surname of either spouse given at birth;
- 10 (3) a combination of surnames; or
- 11 (4) either spouse may elect to hyphenate his or her
12 surname with the surname of the other spouse.

13 (b) Upon entering into a contract of marriage, a spouse may
14 elect to retain his or her middle name before marriage as his or her
15 middle name after marriage, or a spouse may elect to adopt any of the
16 following middle names:

- 17 (1) the current surname of either spouse;
- 18 (2) the surname of either spouse given at birth;
- 19 (3) a combination of the spouse’s current middle name,
20 and the current surname of the other spouse;
- 21 (4) a combination of the spouse’s current middle name
22 and surname;
- 23 (5) a combination of the spouse’s current middle name
24 and the spouse’s surname given at birth; or
- 25 (6) a combination of the spouse’s current middle name,
26 and the other spouse’s surname given at birth.

1 (c) An election by a person to change his or her name pursuant
2 to this Section *shall* serve as a record of the name change. A certified
3 copy of a marriage certificate indicating a person’s new name, or
4 retaining the former name, *shall* constitute proof that the use of the new
5 name or retention of the former name is lawful.”

6 **Section 3.** § 3202(a) of Article 2, Chapter 3, Title 19, Guam Code
7 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

8 “(a) All persons about to be joined in marriage must first obtain a
9 license therefore, from the Department of Public Health and Social Services,
10 which license *shall* state:

- 11 (1) the identity of the parties;
- 12 (2) their full names, residence, and place of birth;
- 13 (3) their date of birth;
- 14 (4) their citizenship;
- 15 (5) if an alien, whether a resident alien or a non-immigrant
16 alien;
- 17 (6) the number of previous marriages, wherever contracted
18 and how terminated; the occupations of the parties; the surname of
19 each, if previously married; the names and birthplaces of each; and, the
20 maiden name of the mother of each;
- 21 (7) whether a spouse elects to retain his or her surname upon
22 marriage as provided for by § 3108;
- 23 (8) whether either party elects to hyphenate or change his or
24 her surname upon marriage as provided for by § 3108;
- 25 (9) whether either party elects to retain or change his or her
26 middle name upon marriage as provided for by § 3108;

1 (10) the social security number of each party; and, if a party
2 does not have a social security number, he or she must state that fact;
3 and

4 (11) whether the applicants elect to have their marriage
5 solemnized by a village Mayor or Vice Mayor.”

6 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* take effect one hundred eighty
7 (180) days after enactment.
