





#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that there is a need to update Guam statutes regarding the choice of a name upon
- 4 marriage. It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to allow a spouse greater options
- 5 relative to his or her choice of a middle name and a surname, or a surname alone,
- 6 upon marriage by indicating such election on a marriage license application.
