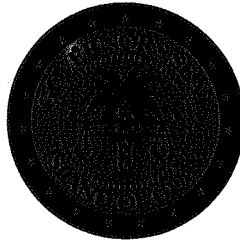



**AN ACT TO AMEND § 3702(a)(2) AND ADD A NEW §
3703(e), BOTH OF ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 22,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
SPECIFYING REFERENCES IN PUBLIC LAW 33-170.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. § 3702(a)(2) of Article 7, Chapter 3, Title 22, Guam Code Annotated, is *amended* to read:

“(2) *Child* (plural: *children*) shall have the same definition as set forth in § 3603(a) of Article 6 of this Chapter, and *employer* shall have the same definition as set forth in § 3603(b)(1) of Article 6 of this Chapter.”

Section 2. A new § 3703(e) is *added* to Article 7 of Chapter 3, Title 22, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

1 “(e) An employee of the government of Guam who is a parent *shall*
2 be granted administrative leave for the purpose of child school-related
3 activities, such as to find, enroll, or re-enroll the employee’s child in a school
4 or with a licensed child care provider, to meet with a teacher or other school
5 official concerning the employee’s child’s performance, to volunteer parental-
6 involvement time at the employee’s child’s school, or to participate in
7 activities of the school or licensed child care provider of his or her child,
8 including attendance at a graduation, school play, school fair, and related
9 events, which *shall* be considered as attendance at an official meeting or
10 conference under Rule No. 8.402 of the Personnel Rules and Regulations of
11 the Department of Administration for purposes of eligibility for administrative
12 leave if the employee, prior to taking the time off, gives reasonable notice to
13 the employer of the planned absence of the employee. The employee may use
14 up to a maximum of four (4) hours every two (2) pay periods of administrative
15 leave for child school-related activities, which may be utilized at the
16 arrangement of the employee with the employee’s supervisor, and may be
17 split into smaller separate segments over the two (2) pay period time frame,
18 but *shall not* carry over to the next two (2) pay periods or thereafter.”

19 **Section 3.** Upon the enactment of this Act, the Department of
20 Administration *shall* provide notification of the provisions of Section 2 of this Act
21 and Executive Order 98-20 to all employees of each governmental entity,
22 department, agency, commission, instrumentality, or public corporation of the
23 government of Guam.
