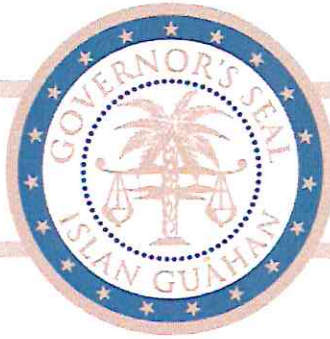

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 3322(e) TO ARTICLE 3,
CHAPTER 3, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE GUAM
DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT A
SCHOOL-LOCATED VACCINATION (SLV) PROGRAM
IN GUAM’S SCHOOLS AND INSTITUTIONS OF
HIGHER LEARNING.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 3322(e) is *added* to Article 3, Chapter 3, Title 10, Guam
3 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

4 “(e) Nothing herein shall be construed or interpreted as to prevent the
5 Guam Department of Education (GDOE) from implementing a School-

1 Located Vaccination (SLV) program in any school or institution of higher
2 learning on Guam for the purpose of administering vaccines required by
3 Subsection (a). Such SLV program may additionally include, but not be
4 limited to, the administering of human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccines, annual
5 influenza (flu shot) vaccines, or any other vaccines not required by Subsection
6 (a), but recommended by the United States Centers for Disease Control and
7 Prevention (CDC). Such SLV programs may be implemented in public
8 schools, individually or on a system-wide basis. GDOE may enroll in the
9 federally-funded Vaccine for Children (VFC) program, overseen by the
10 Department of Public Health and Social Services Immunization Program, as
11 a provider. The Department of Public Health and Social Services
12 Immunization Program may assist GDOE at the start of the SLV Program by
13 providing medical and ancillary supplies (syringes, needles, gloves, biohazard
14 bags, sharps container, band aids, and alcohol prep pads) and may assist in
15 meeting compliance for storage and handling, provide required digital
16 loggers, a proper transport cooler, and if funding is available, a
17 medical/pharmaceutical grade refrigerator.

18 To the extent allowable and practical, the Guam Department of
19 Education may bill any health insurance/plan company, Medicaid, the
20 Medically Indigent Program (MIP), the Child Health Insurance Program
21 (CHIP), or any other party providing coverage for which the child is covered
22 for the cost of the vaccines/immunizations, supplies to administer
23 vaccines/immunizations, the administering of the vaccines/immunizations,
24 and other permitted costs. The Guam Department of Education is not
25 permitted to bill any party for any vaccines or supplies that were received
26 through federal programs or donations where the acceptance of such vaccines
27 and supplies prohibits such billing. Revenues realized from such billing

1 activities shall be used to cover the costs of the Guam Department of
2 Education related to the SLV program, and maintained in a separate fund and
3 bank account. Billing and accounting services may be administered by the
4 Department of Administration or may be outsourced to a private accounting
5 firm. All receipts, expenditures, and financial statements shall be subject to
6 audit and review periodically as determined by the Guam Office of Public
7 Accountability.”
