





**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW ITEM (5) TO § 4109.2(b) OF
ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 4, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING
ADDITIONAL LEAVE THROUGH THE LEAVE SHARING
PROGRAM FOR EMPLOYEES CERTIFIED AS HAVING
A CATASTROPHIC OR CHRONIC ILLNESS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section.1.** A new item (5) is *added* to § 4109.2(b) of Article 1, Chapter 4,

3 Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

1 “(5) An employee certified by his or her attending medical doctor as
2 having a catastrophic or chronic illness, including, but not limited to, a heart
3 attack, stroke, and/or cancer, and who requires additional time beyond the two
4 hundred ten (210) working days authorized pursuant to Subsection (b)(4) of
5 this Section for medical treatment or recovery may be authorized additional
6 leave upon approval by his or her respective department director or appointing
7 authority. Authorization of additional leave for an employee certified as
8 having a catastrophic or chronic illness may be granted upon similar
9 certification from the attending medical doctor made within two (2) weeks of
10 the final thirty (30) day period provided in Subsection (b)(4) of this Section
11 confirming the employee is physically unable to return to work.”

12 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
13 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
14 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
15 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
16 severable.
