The Bureau was created to focus efforts and resources to address the COVID-19 pandemic and prepare and inform our island's response to future emerging infectious diseases, the importance of which cannot be overstated in the current crisis. The budget passed in August 2020 severely cut appropriations to DPHSS during this most critical time. I applaud and support this bill's efforts to rededicate available funds to support DPHSS and the Bureau, and I encourage the legislature to pursue other initiatives to support DPHSS through the COVID-19 pandemic.

THE BUREAU OF EMERGING INFECTIOUS DISEASES.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that Section 5 of Chapter XI of
- 3 Public Law 35-99 appropriated Fourteen Million Eight Hundred Ninety-eight

Thousand Dollars (\$14,898,000) from the General Fund to the Department of 1 Administration to pay the Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) for each eligible retiree 2 3 of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund (GGRF). I Liheslaturan Guåhan further finds that the appropriation made toward the payment of COLA is an 4 estimated total and that there could be a difference in the estimated amount to be 5 paid and the actual amount to be paid. On October 14, 2020, it was announced that 6 the COLA was paid by the GGRF. The GGRF identified that of the amount 7 8 appropriated, only Fourteen Million Four Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand Dollars (\$14,428,000) was expended toward the payment of COLA attributable to the 9

Four Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$470,000) remaining in General Fund appropriations.

I Liheslaturan Guåhan intends to appropriate the remaining funds from the

appropriation in Section 5 of Chapter XI of Public Law 35-99 leaving approximately

General Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social Services for its operations in Fiscal Year 2021, which may include, but not be limited to, the newly created Bureau of Emerging Infectious Diseases.

Section 2. Section 5(a) of Chapter XI of Public Law 35-99 is hereby *amended* to read:

"Section 5. Appropriation for Cost of Living Allowance (COLA).

(a) I Maga'hågan Guåhan shall provide by a single lump sum payment, a Cost of Living Allowance (COLA) of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000) to each retiree of the Government of Guam Retirement Fund (GGRF) who is retired as of September 30, 2020, or his/her survivor, no later than November 1, 2020. If a retiree is a Defined Benefit and a Defined Contribution retiree, the retiree or his/her survivor shall only be entitled to a single COLA payment. The sum of Fourteen Million Four Hundred Twenty-eight Thousand

1	Dollars (\$14,428,000) is appropriated from the General Fund to the
2	Department of Administration for Fiscal Year 2021, to pay said COLA."
3	Section 3. A new Section 12 is hereby added to Chapter XI of Public Law
4	35-99 to read:
5	"Section 12. Appropriation to the Department of Public Health and Social
6	Services. The sum of Four Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars (\$470,000) is
7	appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Public Health and Social
8	Services for its operations in Fiscal Year 2021, which may include, but not be limited
9	to, the Bureau of Emerging Infectious Diseases. This appropriation is not subject to
10	transfer or use for any other purpose other than those identified in this Section."
11	Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
12	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
13	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
14	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
15	severable.
