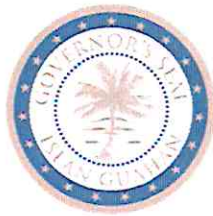



**AN ACT TO *AMEND* SECTIONS 9 AND 19 OF PART II, CHAPTER III OF PUBLIC LAW 35-99, RELATIVE TO MAKING THE NECESSARY APPROPRIATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES, FROM THE HEALTHY FUTURES FUND BALANCE AS OF FISCAL YEAR 2019, REFLECTED IN THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM'S BASIC FINANCIAL STATEMENTS, TO SAFEGUARD THE PUBLIC HEALTH OF THE PEOPLE OF GUAM.**

1       **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2       **Section 1.** Section 9 of Part II, Chapter III of Public Law 35-99 is hereby  
3       *amended* to read as follows:

1           **“Section 9. DPHSS Continuing Appropriation Authorization for**  
2 **MIP and Medicaid.** The unexpended balance of appropriations from the  
3 General Fund and the Healthy Futures Fund to DPHSS for MIP and Medicaid  
4 in Fiscal Year 2020 and Fiscal Year 2021 shall not revert to the General Fund  
5 or the Healthy Futures Fund and shall be available until fully expended for the  
6 original purposes of said appropriations. The Director of DPHSS shall submit  
7 a report to the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* regarding the allocation,  
8 demographics, and expenditures of the appropriations contained herein no  
9 later than thirty (30) days after the end of each quarter and post the same on  
10 the DPHSS website. The Director of Administration shall pay MIP and  
11 Medicaid vendors on a first-in, first-out basis.”

12       **Section 2.** Section 19 of Part II, Chapter III of Public Law 35-99 is hereby  
13 *amended* to read as follows:

14           **“Section 19.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, eighty-five  
15 percent (85%) of the Fiscal Year 2020 fund balance of the Healthy Futures  
16 Fund that was not appropriated in Public Law 35-36, including the amount  
17 reflected in the Fiscal Year 2019 Government of Guam Basic Financial  
18 Statements, Additional Information and Independent Auditors’ Report, is  
19 hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Health and Social Services,  
20 and fifteen percent (15%) shall be appropriated to the Guam Cancer Trust  
21 Fund.”

22       **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

23       **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to  
24 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity  
25 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect  
26 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this  
27 Act are severable.
