AN ACT TO GRANT THE TITLE OF OWNERSHIP OF A SIX THOUSAND ONE HUNDRED TWENTY (6,120) SQUARE METER PORTION OF LOT 5109-REM IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF *TAMUNING* TO THE GUAM REGIONAL TRANSIT AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that this
- 3 legislation is required to expend over Two Hundred Thirty-seven Thousand Five
- 4 Hundred Dollars (\$237,500) in federal funds that are already in hand to design and

- build a mass transit facility to improve services to the people of Guam. These funds
- 2 that are currently in hand must be returned by September 30, 2019 if not expended
- 3 for the architectural and engineering design of the facility.

- Section 2. Grant of the Title of Ownership of a Six Thousand One Hundred Twenty (6,120) Square Meter Portion of Lot 5109-REM in the Municipality of *Tamuning* to the Guam Regional Transit Authority.
- 7 (a) The title of ownership of a six thousand one hundred twenty (6,120) 8 square meter portion of Lot 5109-REM in the municipality of *Tamuning*, as shown on Map 393FY2018, is hereby granted to the Guam Regional Transit Authority for the purpose of developing and constructing a maintenance and office facility for the use of the Guam Regional Transit Authority and the people of Guam.
  - (b) A survey map designating the six thousand one hundred twenty (6,120) square meter portion of Lot 5109-REM in the municipality of *Tamuning* has already been prepared, recorded, and provided by the Department of Land Management to the Guam Regional Transit Authority.
  - **Section 3.** Exemption from Appraisals. 2 GCA, Chapter 2, § 2107(b), relative to land appraisals, *shall not* apply to this Act.
    - **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
