AN ACT TO AMEND § 2104 OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 5, ANNOTATED, **GUAM** CODE RELATIVE TO AND **EXPANDING** THE SCOPE **FUNCTION** OF **MEMBERSHIP** OF THE **ISLANDWIDE** BEAUTIFICATION TASK FORCE.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 2104 of Chapter 2, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
- 3 *amended* to read:
- 4 "§ 2104. Islandwide Beautification Task Force.
- 5 (a) The Lieutenant Governor shall appoint an Islandwide
- 6 Beautification Task Force, consisting of:

1	(1) the Director of the Guam Visitors Bureau;						
2	(2) the Director of the Department of Public Works;						
3	(3) the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation;						
4	(4) the Director of the Department of Agriculture;						
5	(5) the Director of the Department of Corrections;						
6	(6) the Director of the Guam Environmental Protection						
7	Agency;						
8	(7) one (1) member of the Mayors Council of Guam (MCOG)						
9	who is appointed by the MCOG; and						
10	(8) other members as the Chairperson deems necessary.						
11	The Task Force shall be under the direction of the Office of the						
12	Lieutenant Governor, who shall serve as Chairperson of the Task Force.						
13	(b) The Task Force shall work in conjunction with the Mayors						
14	Council of Guam and existing government agencies and private individuals						
15	and organizations to beautify and promote Guam. Its function shall include,						
16	but <i>not</i> be limited to, the coordination of efforts for:						
17	(1) the clearing of overgrown weeds or trees;						
18	(2) the planting of plants or flowers, especially native flora;						
19	(3) the restoration of graffiti-inflicted structures along the						
20	island's highways and scenic areas;						
21	(4) implementing other beautification projects;						
22	(5) preventing littering, preventing the illegal disposal of						
23	waste at unauthorized sites, and preventing the destruction of public						
24	facilities, including parks and beaches;						
25	(6) establishing education, training, or programs of the same;

27	(7) addressing other pertinent issues.						

- 1 (c) The Task Force *shall* purchase only those horticultural products
- grown on Guam."
