**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW ARTICLE 10 TO CHAPTER 77,
DIVISION 2, TITLE 12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED,
RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF
BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAX CREDITS FOR
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE RENOVATION AND
IMPROVEMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GUAM
CALVO FIELD HOUSE AND PARTICIPATION OF THE
GUAM BASKETBALL CONFEDERATION IN THE 2019-
2021 FIBA ASIA CUP COMPETITIONS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

1 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds

2 that the Guam Basketball Confederation is responsible for governing and developing
3 the sport of basketball on Guam, including the Guam National Basketball programs,
4 from the youth to the national teams.

5 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the Guam National Men’s Basketball
6 Team was a two (2)-time Gold Medal winners at the 2015 and 2019 Pacific Games,
7 and was also named as “The Most Outstanding Team” by the Pacific Games Council
8 both times. The Guam National Men’s Basketball Team recorded twenty-four (24)
9 straight wins in FIBA competitions from 2015 to 2019, including the Pacific Games,
10 the Micronesia Games, and the FIBA Asia Cup Pre-Qualifiers. Ranked as #76 in
11 FIBA World Rankings and #14 in Asia, the Guam National Men’s Basketball Team
12 holds the highest ranking in the island’s history.

13 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the Guam National Men’s Basketball
14 Team has attained another opportunity to compete in the FIBA Asia Cup Qualifiers
15 slated to take place during three (3) windows of competition in February 2020,
16 November 2020, and February 2021; and Guam also has the opportunity to host three
17 (3) home games against Hong Kong, New Zealand, and Australia. These games will
18 expose Guam’s beauty and her people to international media sources, whereby
19 millions of international viewers will learn about Guam.

20 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in order to represent Guam
21 effectively, Guam must be prepared to host the games with an approved FIBA
22 facility that includes the required equipment, furnishings, supplies, and other
23 logistical support, to ensure the success of the games, as well as to support the
24 preparation of our Men’s National Basketball Team to compete at the highest level
25 of international basketball. FIBA officials have determined that the University of
26 Guam Calvo Field House (UOG Field House) is the only facility with the approved
27 capacity on Guam but it requires significant enhancement and equipment investment

1 to be able to host the events. The necessary enhancements include: improved lighting
2 in the main court area; locker room and medical room enhancements; new FIBA-
3 approved basketball goals with shot clocks; operating software and hardware for
4 game operations; FIBA Level 1 approved courts; and other requirements.

5 Therefore, it is the intent of *ILiheslaturan Guåhan* to support the Guam Men’s
6 National Basketball Team and the Guam Basketball Confederation in their quest to
7 participate in the FIBA Asia Cup by authorizing tax credits for the preparation and
8 execution of the games on Guam and their participation in international FIBA Asia
9 Cup events.

10 **Section 2.** A new Article 10 is hereby *added* to Chapter 77, Division 2, Title
11 12, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

12 **“ARTICLE 10**

13 **TAX CREDITS FOR GUAM’S PARTICIPATION IN THE 2019-2021 FIBA**
14 **ASIA CUP COMPETITIONS**

15 § 77901. Credit Against Eligible Taxes.

16 § 77902. Limits of Liability.

17 § 77903. Fines and Penalties.

18 § 77904. Cap on Business Privilege Tax Credits for the Rehabilitation,
19 Improvement, and Participation of the Guam Basketball
20 Confederation at the FIBA Asia Cup.

21 § 77905. Filing of Annual Reports.

22 § 77906. Guam Economic Development Authority Report.

23 § 77907. Rules and Regulations.

24 **§ 77901. Credit Against Eligible Taxes.**

25 (a) To the extent that any business contributes to the Guam Basketball
26 Confederation (GBC) to acquire the required equipment and make enhancements to
27 facilities on Guam, as well as the training and transportation of the Guam Men’s

1 National Team for FIBA Asia Cup competitions from 2019 through 2021, it *shall* be
2 entitled to credit of business privilege taxes that are *not* already pledged for any
3 purpose by Guam law. The basis for contribution to the project *shall* be the actual
4 cost of the contribution plus the cost of transportation from the point of origin to its
5 destination.

6 (b) Any unused credits *not* used in the current tax period may be carried
7 over into three (3) subsequent tax periods only, and *shall* expire after the third (3rd)
8 tax period has ended.

9 (c) The total credits allowed under this Article *shall not* exceed the actual
10 dollar amount of the expenditures on the project.

11 (d) The total credits allowed under this Article *shall not* be transferrable to
12 any other business than the original recipient of the credits.

13 **§ 77902. Limits of Liability.**

14 Unless a contractor, materials supplier, designer or landlord/lessor has direct
15 involvement in the operations of the facilities as a director, officer, manager,
16 employee, representative or agent of the Guam Basketball Confederation, they *shall*
17 *not* be held liable for any civil or criminal damages or penalties directly or indirectly
18 arising from or related to the operations, any use, or possession of the gymnasium
19 and facilities, *unless* it can be proven that the materials or design work provided were
20 substandard. As the University of Guam Calvo Field House and facilities is a private
21 venture operated by the University of Guam and for use by the Guam Basketball
22 Confederation, the government of Guam *shall not* be liable for any claims or
23 damages arising from the operation of the gymnasium and facilities. The Guam
24 Basketball Confederation, its directors, agents, consultants, employees, or other
25 affiliated person or persons shall make no representation that the government of
26 Guam has any interest in the operation of such gymnasium and facilities.

27 **§ 77903. Fines and Penalties.**

1 To the extent that a company providing materials and services for the project
2 contained herein takes more tax benefits in terms of business privilege taxes than the
3 actual value of the materials or services contributed to the project authorized herein,
4 that company *shall* be required to pay all interest and penalties applicable under
5 Guam law and the Internal Revenue Code for failure to pay taxes, in addition to
6 payment of the actual taxes due. To the extent that any individual, officer, director
7 or other person having interest in a company providing materials or services for the
8 project contained herein knowingly and willingly causes such company to take more
9 tax benefits in terms of business privilege taxes than the actual value of the materials
10 or services contributed to the project, such individual *shall* be guilty of a felony in
11 the third degree punishable by a fine of *not less than* Five Thousand Dollars
12 (\$5,000), or one (1) year in prison, or both.

13 **§ 77904. Cap on Business Privilege Tax Credits for the Rehabilitation,**
14 **Improvement, and Participation of the Guam Basketball Confederation in the**
15 **FIBA Asia Cup.**

16 (a) The total amount of credits against unpledged business privilege taxes
17 for the GBC's preparation of facilities and participation in the FIBA Asia Cup
18 competitions authorized herein *shall not* exceed Four Hundred Thousand Dollars
19 (\$400,000) over a two (2) year period.

20 (b) If, at the expiration of the two (2) year period authorized pursuant to
21 this Article, there are still unclaimed authorized tax credits, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*
22 may, in its discretion, extend the eligible period for one (1) additional year.

23 (c) *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* may, in its discretion, extend the term and
24 modify any part of the program based on future opportunities to host and participate
25 in international competitions and promote teams from Guam.

26 (d) The Guam Basketball Confederation *shall* create a memorandum of
27 understanding with the University of Guam in order to detail the enhancement and

1 use of the University of Guam Calvo Field House (UOG Field House) for sports
2 competitions organized by GBC, to include operational plans for equipment being
3 acquired by GBC for use at the UOG Field House.

4 (e) Equipment, labor, materials, construction, transportation,
5 accommodations and professional services *shall* be competitively procured.

6 **§ 77905. Filing of Annual Reports.**

7 (a) The Guam Basketball Confederation *shall* annually submit a copy of
8 the financial statement required pursuant to § 14102, Chapter 14, Title 18 GCA to
9 the Speaker of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the Public Auditor, and the Administrator of
10 GEDA.

11 (b) The Guam Basketball Confederation *shall* annually submit a detailed
12 report of the expenses eligible for tax credits incurred to the Speaker of *I*
13 *Liheslaturan Guåhan*, the Public Auditor, and the Administrator of GEDA.

14 (c) The Guam Basketball Confederation *shall* ensure that its articles and
15 by-laws are current, and should there be any amendments to such articles and by-
16 laws, it *shall* immediately file such amendments with the Department of Revenue
17 and Taxation.

18 **§ 77906. Guam Economic Development Authority Report.**

19 The Guam Economic Development Authority (GEDA) *shall* submit a report
20 to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* detailing the impact of the program on the business
21 privilege taxes, sports, and economic activities on Guam. GEDA *shall* also include
22 in its report its monitoring efforts and any other information related to the program.
23 The report *shall* be transmitted to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* on an annual basis until the
24 tax credit cap pursuant to § 77904 of this Article is exhausted.

25 **§ 77907. Rules and Regulations.**

26 GEDA *shall* implement and monitor the tax credit program authorized
27 pursuant to this Article based on rules and regulations already adopted by GEDA for

1 previous tax credit programs. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, GEDA
2 *shall* have the authority to incorporate and add rules and regulations necessary to
3 process travel-related tax credits which *shall* use, at a minimum, the Federal Travel
4 Regulation as a basis for such rules and regulations.”

5 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.

6 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
8 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act which can be given effect
9 without the invalid provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this
10 Act are severable.
