1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, is hereby amended
- 3 to read:

1	"Section 8. Guam Retirement Security Plan. The sum of Two						
2	Hundred One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-four Dollars (\$201,464) is						
3	hereby appropriated from the General Fund to fund the Guam Retirement						
4	Security Plan established by Public Law 33-186."						
5	Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Election Commission. The sum						
6	of Two Hundred Ninety-eight Thousand Five Hundred Thirty-six Dollars						
7	(\$298,536) is appropriated from the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam						
8	Election Commission for the sole purpose of paying expenditures related to the 2018						
9	Primary and General Elections. The sum of One Hundred Nine Thousand Six						
10	Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$109,650) is authorized from the appropriation in this						
11	Section to pay prior year obligations of the Guam Election Commission for 2018						
12	Primary Election expenditures.						
13	Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.						
14	Section 4. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any						
15	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall						
16	not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without						
17	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are						
18	severable.
