Today I signed Bill No. 24-35 (COR) "An Act to Amend § 2103.4(n) of Chapter 2, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, Relative clarifying the Ninety (90) Day Limit on Acting Appointments," (the "Act") into law as **Public Law 35-8**.

I do not agree that this Act clarifies prior law; rather, it sets forth a new calculation of the ninety (90) day limit to an acting appointment, a calculation that now clearly reflects one side of an argument that occurred last year.







AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 2103.4(n) OF CHAPTER 2, TITLE 4, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO CLARIFYING THE NINETY (90) DAY TIME LIMIT ON ACTING APPOINTMENTS.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that appointments expire ninety (90) days from the date of the initial acting
4 appointment by *I Maga'håga* (the Governor) or appointing officials, excluding
5 intervening weekends and holidays.

6 It is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to clarify that the ninety (90) day time
7 limit *shall* mean ninety (90) calendar days.

1 **Section 2.** § 2103.4(n) of Chapter 2, Title 4, Guam Code Annotated, is
2 *amended* to read:

3 “(n) Ninety (90) days - in computing the ninety (90) day time limit
4 imposed in this Chapter, the term ninety (90) days *shall* mean ninety (90)
5 calendar_days from the date of the initial acting appointment.”

6 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall*
8 *not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
10 severable.

11 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
