AN ACT TO SUSPEND THE TWO PERCENT (2%) GENERAL FUND DEPOSIT INTO THE RAINY DAY FUND REQUIREMENT, AS MANDATED BY 5 GCA § 22904, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that the economic impact of the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) will inevitably result in a decline in revenues collected for the General Fund, thereby inhibiting the government of Guam's ability to not only meet its adopted revenue levels for Fiscal Year 2020 but to also respond to the existing public health

- 1 emergency. Despite this likelihood, I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds that it remains a
- 2 requirement under 5 GCA § 22904, to deposit two percent (2%) of the total revenues
- 3 projected for the General Fund for each fiscal year into the Rainy Day Fund.
- 4 Moreover, under 5 GCA § 22904, monies deposited into the Rainy Day Fund may
- 5 only be transferred through legislative authorization, even if such monies were used
- 6 for expenses caused by a Guam emergency. I Liheslaturan Guåhan understands that
- 7 there continues to be large uncertainty surrounding the extent and duration of the
- 8 COVID-19 pandemic and its impact to not only the government's revenue
- 9 collections, but also to Guam's overall economy, and *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* desires
- 10 to provide I Maga'hågan Guåhan with the ultimate flexibility to address this
- 11 unprecedented public health emergency situation.
- 12 It is, therefore, the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to suspend the two percent
- 13 (2%) General Fund deposit requirement as mandated by 5 GCA § 22904.
- 14 Section 2. Suspension of Rainy Day Fund Deposit Requirement.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, or rule or regulation, the requirement
- to deposit into the Rainy Day Fund under 5 GCA § 22904, is hereby suspended for
- 17 Fiscal Year 2020.
- Nothing herein shall prevent I Maga'hågan Guåhan from making such
- deposits into the Rainy Day Fund as she deems necessary.
- Section 3. Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any
- 21 person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions
- or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or
- application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
