Dear Acting Speaker:

I have always believed that it is better to light a candle than curse the darkness. **AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE TEN MILLION DOLLARS
(\$10,000,000) FROM THE HOSPITAL CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT FUND TO THE GUAM MEMORIAL
HOSPITAL AUTHORITY FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority has three (3) critical capital
4 improvement projects necessary to the function of the hospital in its entirety. *I*
5 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that these capital improvement projects are
6 mandates raised by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services.

1 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate funds from
2 the Hospital Capital Improvement Fund established in Section 5 of Part I, Chapter
3 III, Public Law 35-36 (the *General Appropriations Act of 2020*) to the Guam
4 Memorial Hospital Authority for capital improvement projects.

5 **Section 2. Appropriation.** Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) from the
6 Hospital Capital Improvement Fund is hereby appropriated to the Guam Memorial
7 Hospital Authority (GMHA). Such funds *shall* be used for the following capital
8 improvement projects for GMHA: (1) to repair or replace the electrical panel and
9 necessary generator; (2) to repair the roof; and (3) to procure an electronic health
10 records system.
