Bill No. 20-35(COR) – An Act to Amend Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, Relative to Reducing the Guam Retirement Security Plan Appropriation by Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000); and Appropriating the Same From the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Police Department for Security Cameras and Related Equipment

Dear Madam Speaker:

Attached is Bill No. 20-35(COR) "An Act to Amend Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, Relative to Reducing the Guam Retirement Security Plan Appropriation by Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000); and Appropriating the Same From the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Police Department for Security Cameras and Related Equipment," which I have **VETOED** due to a technical flaw.

In early April, I signed P.L. 35-7 which sought to amend Section 8 of Chapter XI of Public Law 34-116. That law reduced appropriated funds from the Guam Retirement Security Plan Appropriation ("GRSP") from Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000) to Two Hundred One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-four Dollars (\$201,464). The difference was appropriated to the Guam Election Commission to cover costs incurred during the 2018 election cycle.

This bill, in attempting to do the same and appropriate funds from the GRSP, did not take into account the residual appropriation left by P.L. 35-7. The 2019 FY Budget had been fully allocated; therefore, there are insufficient funds to appropriate Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) to GRSP and an additional Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000) to the Guam Police Department.

I wholeheartedly support the intent of this bill. The use of security cameras will greatly assist the Guam Police Department in making our island safer. This is why I have attached proposed legislation with the corrected language. I hope that the Legislature will act swiftly to send it back to me for my signature.

**Section 1.** Section 8 of Chapter XI, Public Law 34-116, is hereby *amended* to read:

"Section 8. Guam Retirement Security Plan. The sum of One Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Four Dollars (\$1,464.00) is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to fund the Guam Retirement Security Plan established by Public Law 33-186."

**Section 2. Appropriation to the Guam Police Department.** The sum of Two Hundred Thousand Dollars **(\$200,000)** is hereby appropriated from the General Fund in Fiscal Year 2019 to the Guam Police Department to assist with the deterrence and reporting of criminal activity. Funds *shall* be used to purchase, operate, and maintain security cameras and related equipment in
