# AN ACT TO AMEND § 3105 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 3, TITLE 22, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RESPONSIBLY RAISING THE MINIMUM WAGE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 3105 of Article 1, Chapter 3, Title 22, Guam Code Annotated,
  is hereby *amended* to read:
- 4 "§ 3105. Minimum Wages.
- Every employer *shall* pay each person employed by him wages at a rate not less than Eight Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$8.25) per hour, effective January 1, 2015; *not less than* Eight Dollars and Seventy-Five Cents (\$8.75) per hour, effective March 1, 2020; and *not less than* Nine Dollars and Twenty-Five Cents (\$9.25) per hour, effective March 1, 2021."
