**AN ACT TO AMEND §19603 OF TITLE 11 GUAM CODE  
ANNOTATED CHAPTER 19 ARTICLE 6 RELATIVE TO  
VACCINATION AND TREATMENT DURING A  
DECLARED STATE OF PUBLIC HEALTH  
EMERGENCY**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. §19603 of Title 11 Guam Code Annotated Chapter 19 Article 6**  
3 **is hereby amended to read as follows:**

4 § 19603. Vaccination and Treatment.

5 During a state of public health emergency, the public health authority may  
6 exercise the following emergency powers over persons as necessary to address the  
7 public health emergency.

8 (a) Vaccination. To vaccinate persons as protection against infectious disease  
9 and to prevent the spread of contagious or possibly contagious disease.

10 (1) Vaccination may be performed by any qualified person authorized to do  
11 so by the public health authority.

12 (2) A vaccine to be administered must be unconditionally approved (not  
13 Emergency Use Authorization) by the United States Food & Drug Administration

1 and not be such as is reasonably likely to lead to serious harm to the affected  
2 individual.

3 (3) To prevent the spread of contagious or possibly contagious disease the  
4 public health authority may isolate or quarantine, pursuant to §19604, persons who  
5 are unable or unwilling for reasons of health, religion or conscience to undergo  
6 vaccination pursuant to this Section.

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately upon  
8 enactment.
