AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1(d) OF CHAPTER V, PUBLIC LAW 36-54, RELATIVE TO PRIORITIZING VETERANS' SERVICES BY EXEMPTING THE GUAM OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS (OVA) FROM THE BUREAU OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT RESEARCH'S ALLOTMENT RELEASE CONTROL AND APPROPRIATIONS RESERVE AUTHORITY, AND BY AUTHORIZING THE GUAM OVA TO UTILIZE THE UNEXPENDED BALANCE OF FUNDS APPROPRIATED TO THE AGENCY PURSUANT TO PUBLIC LAW 35-99.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that on January 28, 2022, the Guam Office of Veterans Affairs (OVA) notified the
- 4 36th Guam Legislature of a payment to the Guam Power Authority for a prior
- 5 years' obligation. The report was submitted pursuant to Section 20 of Chapter XIII,
- 6 Public Law 36-54, which authorizes the expenditure of Fiscal Year 2022
- 7 appropriations for prior years' obligations, provided such payments do not
- 8 negatively impact the current operational needs of government of Guam
- 9 departments and agencies.
- 10 I Liheslatura further finds that according to information the Bureau of
- 11 Budget and Management Research provided in the Appropriation Reserve Report

1	for the Quarter Ending December 31, 2021, which was submitted to the 36th Guam					
2	Legislature on January 31, 2022, \$207,251 of \$968,605 that was appropriated to					
3	Guam Office of Veterans Affairs for Fiscal Year 2022 has been set aside as an					
4	appropriation reserve. The Bureau of Budget and Management Research					
5	previously reported as of September 30, 2021, that \$98,446 of \$731,692 (inclusive					
6	of \$150,000 transferred from the Office of the Governor), which was appropriated					
7	to the Guam Office of Veterans Affairs during Fiscal Year 2021 had been set asid					
8	as an appropriation reserve.					
9	It is, therefore, the intent of I Liheslatura to prioritize veterans' services by					
10	ensuring the Guam Office of Veterans Affairs has full access to its Fiscal Year					
11	2022 budget appropriation and to the unexpended balance of the agency's Fiscal					
12	Year 2021 budget appropriation. Through this Act, I Liheslatura exempts the					
13	Guam OVA from the Bureau of Budget and Management Research's allotment					
14	release control and appropriations reserve authority and further authorizes the					
15	Guam OVA to utilize the unexpended balance of funds appropriated to the agency					
16	pursuant to Public Law 35-99.

18	Section 2. Section 1(d) of Chapter V, Public Law 36-54, is amended to					
19	read:					
20	"(d) GUAM OFFICE OF VETERANS AFFAIRS (OVA)					
21	(1) Appropriation. The sum of Nine Hundred Sixty-eight Thousand					
22	Six Hundred Five Dollars (\$968,605) is appropriated from the General Fund					
23	to the Guam Office of Veterans Affairs (OVA) for its operations for Fiscal					
24	Year 2022.

3	(2) Exemption from BBMR Allotment Release Control and
4	Appropriation Reserves. Pursuant to § 1303.1 of Article 3, Chapter 1, Title 5
5	GCA, the management of allotments by the Bureau of Budget and
6	Management Research (BBMR) shall not apply to the Guam Office of
7	Veterans Affairs. Allotments to the Guam OVA shall be based on the FY
8	2022 drawdown schedule established by BBMR and the Guam OVA.
9	BBMR shall not be authorized to hold any appropriation reserves on funds
10	appropriated to the Guam OVA. The Department of Administration shall
11	provide cash disbursements to the Guam OVA for the General Fund
12	appropriation made to the Guam OVA in this Act.
13	(3) Continuing Appropriation Authorization. Notwithstanding any
14	other provision of law, the unexpended balance of funds appropriated to the
15	Guam Office of Veterans Affairs in Public Law 35-99 shall not lapse and
16	shall continue to be available until fully expended and is not subject to
17	transfer or use for any other purpose."

19	Section 3. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
