AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 1102.04 TO CHAPTER 1, DIVISION 4, TITLE 2, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, RELATIVE TO INCENTIVIZING THE PROCUREMENT OF ZERO EMISSIONS VEHICLES BY THE GOVERNMENT OF GUAM.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 1102.04 is hereby *added* to Chapter 1, Division 4, Title 2, of Title 5, Guam Administrative Rules and Regulations, to read:

## "§ 1102.04 Zero Emissions Vehicle Preference.

The Chief Procurement Officer, the Director of Public Works, or the head of the Purchasing Agency *shall*, whenever practicable, procure zero-emissions vehicles. The cost (prior to any adjustments for local vendors) of a zero-emissions vehicle may be as much as three percent (3%) greater than the cost of similarly performing vehicle with an internal combustion engine. Said costs shall include expected lifecycle costs, including maintenance, lifespan, and costs associated with refueling and recharging. This section shall not prevent the government of Guam from opting to procure only zero-emissions vehicles on a case-by-case basis, at which point the comparative cost of non zero-emissions vehicles shall not apply.

The Chief Procurement Officer, the Director of Public Works, or the head of a Purchasing Agency *shall* determine the authenticity of any statement that a vehicle is zero-emissions, and whether such vehicle meets the performance needs of the government of Guam. If the bidder qualifies under this section a three percent (3%) preference shall be given. The three percent (3%) preference shall only be given until the cost of zero-emission vehicles gain parity."

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective one (1) year after

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective one (1) year after enactment.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity *shall not* affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are severable.
