**AN ACT TO AMEND §1112.3(e) OF CHAPTER 1 TITLE
12, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
PROVIDING PARITY FOR THE GUAM AIRPORT
CIVILIAN VOLUNTEER POLICE RESERVE.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. *Legislative Findings and Intent.* *I Liheslaturan* finds that upon the increase of stipends for Guam's various Law Enforcement Reservists, this has made it more attractive for the Guam Airport Civilian Volunteer Police Reservists to serve in other Law Enforcement Entities. As a result, *all* Airport Police Reservists have migrated to other agencies. The Guam International Airport Police has evolved into a more than capable law enforcement entity, stepping up to fill in the needs of the Guam Police Department. As evident with the recent COVID-19 Pandemic, the Guam Airport Police are on the front-lines, facing an emerging threat on a regular basis. With increased calls for mutual-aid, and a force that is filled with officers who are also members of our Armed Forces, *I Liheslaturan* finds that it is imperative for the Chief of the Airport Police to be able to attract candidates to continue to effectively protect Guam's Airport and ultimately our community at large.

Section 2. §1112.3(e) of Chapter 21, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

1 (e) Same: Allowance. Each member of the Civilian Volunteer Airport Police
2 Reserve who successfully completes probationary requirements as established by
3 the Chief of Airport Police, and who contributes a minimum of forty-two (42) hours
4 or more per month, shall receive an allowance of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars
5 ~~(\$250.00)~~ \$500.00 per month, to defray the cost of maintenance of equipment and
6 uniforms. The Airport shall identify funds for appropriation to satisfy the intent of
7 this Section.

8 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
9 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
10 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
11 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
12 severable.

13 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This act shall be effective immediately upon
14 enactment.
