









AN ACT TO AMEND § 77104.1 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER 77, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO INCLUDING ALL PEACE OFFICERS IN THE ENFORCEMENT OF ALCOHOL FREE ZONES.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 77104.1 of Article 1, Chapter 77, Title 21, Guam Code
3 Annotated, is hereby *amended*, to read:

4 **“§ 77104.1. Establishment of an Alcohol Free Zone.**

5 Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation, there is established
6 within the Guam Territorial Park system “Alcohol Free Zones”, as defined in
7 this Chapter. Any person who possesses or consumes alcohol in an “Alcohol
8 Free Zone” shall be in violation of this provision and shall be issued a citation
9 and punished in accordance with § 77104.2 of this Chapter. All Territorial

1 ~~Park Patrol and Guam Police~~peace officers, as defined in 17 GCA, § 51101(b),
2 shall have jurisdiction to enforce this provision of law.”

3 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* become effective upon
4 enactment.
