3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Frances “Pinky” Baza Hills was born on May 21, 1961; she
4 is the daughter of Pete Untalan Baza and Julie Frances Reyes of *Hågat*, and she married

1 Dwight “Ike” Eisenhower Hills on November 22, 1980; and together, they are the proud
2 parents and grandparents to their two (2) children and grandchildren; and

3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Frances “Pinky” Baza Hills’ commitment to public safety
4 began in 1976 when she participated in the first Department of Public Safety Law
5 Enforcement Explorer Program; and after graduating from George Washington High
6 School in 1978, she furthered her education and enrolled in the Criminal Justice
7 Program at the Guam Community College and became a Peace Officer in 1979 after
8 graduating with the 22nd Police Recruit Academy Cycle of the Guam Police
9 Department; and


10 **WHEREAS**, in January 1995, Mrs. Frances “Pinky” Baza Hills began her career
11 with the Guam Department of Labor working at the Alien Labor Processing and
12 Certification Division, where she held the position of Law Enforcement Specialist III;
13 and in 2018, she joined the Division of Guam Occupational Safety and Health
14 Administration; and further on throughout her career, she aided the agency in
15 investigating and enforcing the Wage and Hour Law, the Child Labor Law, and other
16 labor standards; and

17 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Frances “Pinky” Baza Hills’ dedication to the people of Guam
18 and the Guam Department of Labor was most commendable during the major natural
19 disasters of Typhoon Paka in November of 1997, Typhoon Chata’an in July of 2002,
20 and Super Typhoon Pongsona in December of 2002, which was one of the most intense
21 typhoons to ever strike the island; now therefore, be it


22 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Sais Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
