We are in support of this Bill with the following information and recommendations.

1. The fund should only be for those who have been identified by the Courts as "Indigent" and are assigned legal counsel because of their financial condition. Many of the inmates and detainees incarcerated are not indigent and have adequate personal funds to pay for their phone services. Please take note that this system of payment is a nationally recognized phone system with the same implemented pay system.
2. We recommend that such funding should be made available to the Public Defender's Office to pay for the phone services through our Paytel system. In this way, there is full accountability of where the funds are being directed and the number of inmates utilizing the system due to their financial status.
3. We conducted a recent free phone service recently for the Public Defender's Office to communicate with their clients. The average amounts were about \$400 per month for indigent inmates.
4. For several months now we have allowed attorneys to visit their clients personally using COVID social distancing protocols and other preventive measures. Attorneys are free to meet with their clients in person with prior notice for scheduling. We are now at PCORE 3 and will be implementing limited family visitation this month.
