The Bureau requests that Bill No. 85-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 85-36 is an act to amend § 15301 of Article 3 and § 15407 of Article 4, both of Chapter 15, Title 4 of the Guam Code Annotated, relative to reaffirming the autonomy and independence of the Guam Ethics Commission. Furthermore, the proposed legislation intends to codify the appointment of an Executive Director for the Commission and the duties of the position.

As the Bill is administrative in nature, it poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
