

1/The proposed legislation intents to amend §1112.3 (e) of Chapter 1, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, relative to providing parity for the Guam Airport Civilian Volunteer Police Reserve. The bill, if passed, would increase the monthly stipend allowance from \$250 to \$500 per month for each Police Reserve Volunteer. Per the Guam International Airport Authority (GIAA), the GIAA does not have any Guam Airport Civilian Volunteer Police Reservist at this time. Absent any additional information, the Bureau is unable to determine an accurate cost impact. However, should the GIAA hire ten (10) individuals under the program it would need to budget an additional cost of \$60,000 (\$500 stipend x 10 reservist x 12 months) per fiscal year.
