The Bureau requests that Bill No. 149-36 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 149-36 (COR) is "AN ACT TO ADOPT THE RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK AS TRANSMITTED BY THE GUAM ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY."

Per the Guam Environmental Protection Agency (GEPA), the UST Rules and Regulations were submitted to the 35th Guam Legislature on October 27, 2020. A public hearing was held on December 4, 2020. The 35th Guam Legislature did not reject or amend the UST Rules and Regulations and, therefore, the Rules and Regulations were deemed approved on December 11, 2020, as provided by 10 GCA §45106. The UST Rules and Regulations, however, were not transmitted by the 35th Guam Legislature to the Guam Compiler of Laws. Guam EPA is therefore submitting the UST Rules and Regulations to the 36th Guam Legislature, with a copy to the Compiler of Laws, to complete the rulemaking process.

As such, the bill is administrative in nature.

Re: Underground Storage Tank Rules and Regulations transmitted to the 35th Guam Legislature

Buenas yan Hafa Adai Madam Speaker,


The Guam Environmental Protection Agency submitted the enclosed Underground Storage Tank ("UST") Rules and Regulations to the 35th Guam Legislature on October 27, 2020. The UST Rules and Regulations were sent to the Speaker of the Legislature with the subject line "'This is a Transmittal to *I Lihesturan Guahan* of Proposed Rules and Regulations pursuant to the Administrative Adjudication Law.'" The submission included a printed and an identical electronic (pdf and word) version of the proposed rules and regulations, and a printed and an identical electronic (pdf) copy of the entire agency record, including a resolution showing board approval of proposed rules, certification of the agency record and compliance with each of the requirements of the Guam Administrative Adjudication Law, an economic impact statement, a transcript of the public hearing on the rules being proposed, and evidence of the Governor's and the Attorney General's approvals.

The 35th Guam Legislature Committee on Environment, Revenue and Taxation, and Procurement held a public hearing on December 4, 2020. Representatives from Guam EPA attended the hearing and provided oral and written testimony. The 35th Guam Legislature did not reject or amend the UST Rules and Regulations, and the UST Rules and Regulations were deemed approved on December 11, 2020, as provided by 10 GCA §45106. The UST Rules and Regulations, however, were not transmitted by the 35th Guam Legislature to the Guam Compiler of Laws. Guam EPA is therefore submitting the UST Rules and Regulations to the 36th Guam Legislature, with a copy to the Compiler of Laws, to complete the rulemaking process.


