Buenas yan Hafa Adai Madame Speaker:

A person's name is a significant part of their identity, how they view themselves, how they project themselves, and how they are perceived by others. The same is true with villages. It is commonly known and accepted that the village many of us have come to identify as Inarajan was historically known as Inalahan. The village of Inalahan is home to many cultural landmarks and traditional iconography, and remains a stronghold of CHamoru identity today. While the name Inarajan does not appear to hold any historical or cultural significance, the name Inalahan held and still holds great importance for the residents of the village and visitors alike. Though the difference may appear subtle and restoring the traditional name may appear intellectually inconsequential or practically inconvenient, as Guam modernizes, it is more important than ever that we take stock of and value who we were as a people, and that we move forward with place names that reflect who we still are today. For these reasons, it is with pleasure that I sign Bill No. 60-36 into law as **Public Law No. 36-16**.

### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 Section 1. § 403(h) of Chapter 4, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby

3 *amended* to read:

"(h) Municipality of Inalåhan. Beginning at the mouth of the 1 2 Talofofo River running easterly, southerly and southwesterly along the 3 southeastern coastline to the mouth of the Ajayan River, thence northwesterly 4 along said river to the Mt. Sasalaguan Triangulation Station, thence 5 northwesterly to Mt. Bolanos Triangulation Station, thence northeasterly and 6 southeasterly along the northern boundary of Estate No. 322 (Atate) to the point of its intersection with the Ugum River, thence northeasterly along the 7 8 Ugum and Talofofo Rivers to the point of beginning."

9 Section 2. All references to "*Inarajan*" in the Guam Code Annotated and
10 the laws, rules, and regulations of Guam shall be understood to refer to "*Inalåhan*."
