

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Guam Solid Waste Authority (GSWA) Board of Directors has been
4 searching for a General Manager since August 2020; and also finds that within the
5 past eight (8) months, GSWA received several applications for the position from

1 interested individuals, whose educational qualifications are not specifically listed in
2 the current GSWA statute.

3 Therefore, *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* intends to amend the minimum
4 qualifications for the GSWA General Manager position by expanding the type of
5 education required.

6 **Section 2.** § 51A106(a)(2) of Article 1, Chapter 51A, Title 10, Guam Code
7 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

8 “(2) graduation from an accredited institution of higher education
9 with a bachelor’s degree in Business Management, Engineering Management,
10 Engineering Technology, Civil Engineering, Environmental Science,
11 Environmental Engineering, or a closely related field or discipline. If in the
12 best interest of the Authority, the Board may consider other related industry
13 trainings and certifications.”

14 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
15 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
16 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
17 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
18 severable.
