Buenas yan Hafa Adai Madame Speaker:

The Guam Territorial Park System is used by so many members of our community to gather for occasions, enjoy Guam's beautiful sunsets, and participate in recreational activities. As it became more apparent that outdoor activities are significantly less risky than indoor ones for the transmission of COVID-19, use of our Park System increased. Those participating in such outdoor activities often include families who desire to enjoy Guam's beautiful scenery in surroundings without the presence of alcohol. Bill 95-36 expands authority to enforce the System's alcohol-free zones to all peace officers of the government of Guam, not just Guam Police officers or officers from the Park Patrol of the Department of Revenue and Taxation. These additional resources will allow for a more robust enforcement method so that we can all enjoy cleaner and safer parks. Bill No. 95-36 (LS) is now **Public Law 36-52**.





**AN ACT TO AMEND § 77104.1 OF ARTICLE 1, CHAPTER
77, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE
TO INCLUDING ALL PEACE OFFICERS IN THE
ENFORCEMENT OF ALCOHOL-FREE ZONES WITHIN
THE GUAM TERRITORIAL PARK SYSTEM.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** § 77104.1 of Article 1, Chapter 77, Title 21, Guam Code
3 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read:

4 **“§ 77104.1. Establishment of an Alcohol-Free Zone.**

5 Notwithstanding any other law, rule or regulation, there is established
6 within the Guam Territorial Park system “Alcohol Free Zones,” as defined in

1 this Chapter. Any person who possesses or consumes alcohol in an “Alcohol
2 Free Zone” shall be in violation of this provision and shall be issued a citation
3 and punished in accordance with § 77104.2 of this Chapter. All Peace
4 Officers, as defined in 17 GCA § 51101(b), shall have jurisdiction to enforce
5 this Section.”

6 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
