Guam has made progress in reducing the use of single use plastic and paper bags. This progress is an important step in reducing the amount of waste we as an island dispose of each year. Prohibiting the use of the single use paper bags will limit both the pollution caused during the manufacturing process and their impact on the land fill after their use. However, by extending the deadline for the use of the paper bags we are preventing the retailers from simply disposing of a large number of bags in their inventory into our landfill without having a viable replacement for the paper bags. Bill No. 245-36 creates a good compromise taking into account the needs of the environment and Guam's Business Community. I hereby sign Bill No. 245-36 in law as Public Law 36-98.

in 26 GARR § 4404(f), with a valid sanitary permit issued by the Division of 1 2 Environmental Health of the Department of Public Health and Social 3 Services." Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective upon enactment. 4 5 **Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any 6 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without 7 8 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are 9 severable.
