



**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (f) TO § 80.37 OF
ARTICLE 2, CHAPTER 80, TITLE 9, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE POSSESSION OR
USE OF AN EXPLOSIVE OR AN IMPROVISED
EXPLOSIVE DEVICE IN THE COMMISSION OF A
FELONY.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new Subsection (f) is *added* to § 80.37 of Article 2, Chapter
3 80, Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, to read:

4 “(f) Whoever possesses or uses an explosive device as defined in 10 GCA,
5 Chapter 61, § 61100, or an improvised explosive device (defined as those devices
6 that are placed or fabricated in an improvised manner incorporating destructive,

1 lethal, noxious, pyrotechnic, or incendiary chemicals and designed to destroy,
2 incapacitate, harass, or distract, which may incorporate military weapons, but are
3 normally devised from non-military components) in the commission of a felony
4 punishable under the laws of Guam shall, in addition to the punishment imposed for
5 the commission of such felony, be imprisoned for a term of not less than ten (10)
6 years nor more than twenty-five (25) years.”

7 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
8 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
9 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
10 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
11 severable.

12 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
