



AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE GUAM POLICE DEPARTMENT (GPD) TO USE THE UNEXPENDED BALANCE OF THE APPROPRIATION AUTHORIZED IN SECTION 2 OF PUBLIC LAW 35-22 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROCURING AUDIOVISUAL RECORDING EQUIPMENT TO BE USED DURING INTERVIEWS CONDUCTED BY GPD PERSONNEL.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* (the Guam
3 Legislature) finds that the current practice of the audiovisual recording of interviews
4 conducted by detectives of the Criminal Investigations Division of the Guam Police
5 Department (GPD) has proven valuable in providing an accurate record of the

1 interaction between detectives and suspects, the protection of rights, and for training
2 purposes. Such recordings protect police officers from false claims of misconduct,
3 protect the rights of suspects, and serve as evidence in further proceedings. *I*
4 *Liheslatura* (the Legislature) further finds that the expansion of GPD's capability to
5 record complaints and interviews at the police precinct level would serve to enhance
6 the benefits of its current system.

7 **Section 2.** The Guam Police Department (GPD) is hereby authorized to use
8 the unexpended balance of the sum authorized in Section 2 of Public Law 35-22 for
9 the purpose of procuring audiovisual recording equipment to be used during
10 interviews conducted by GPD personnel.
