AN ACT TO AMEND § 4719 OF ARTICLE 7, CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 26, GUAM ADMINISTRATIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS, RELATIVE TO COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS AND REGULATIONS FOR DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- Section 1. § 4719 of Article 7, Chapter 4, Division 1, Title 26, Guam
- 3 Administrative Rules and Regulations, is hereby *amended* to read:
- 4 "§ 4719. Existing Facilities.
- 5 (a) School facilities in existence at the time that these regulations
- take effect shall be given five (5) years from the date that these rules become

effective to come into full compliance with the requirements of these rules unless a school facility or operator files a written statement of exception with the Director and receives a variance as provided in § 4722.

- (b) Guam Department of Education (GDOE) public school facilities shall come into full compliance by the start of School Year 2024-2025 with the requirements of these rules unless a public school facility or operator files a written statement of exception with the Director and receives a variance as provided in § 4722.
- (c) GDOE shall submit monthly written reports to the Speaker of *I* Liheslaturan Guåhan detailing the status of each public school's compliance or non-compliance with these rules and regulations that will result in the suspension of the sanitary permit of a GDOE public school. Such report shall include, but not be limited to, the proposed corrective action(s) which will be taken to avoid suspension of its sanitary permit or to support GDOE's request for a variance under this Chapter.
- (d) Until such time as all GDOE public schools have obtained sanitary permits required under this Chapter, GDOE shall be subject to monthly oversight hearings to report on the status of its compliance or non-compliance with these rules and regulations."
